MILK FOODS.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices (Food), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. C—112 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,600 of September 13, 1946;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per case, and the maximum retail price per tin or bottle above which the brand of milk food specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule and of the standard pack specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that Schedule shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that paragraphs (iii.) to (v.) of my Food Price Order No. C—63 relating to preserved milk and milk foods, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,435 of July 20, 1945, shall apply in the case of the milk food of the description named and specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,054 of

December 21, 1942, I, Cedric James Oorloff, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Hambantota District, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from January 1, 1947, the Order on Kerosene Oil dated August 20, 1946, published in the *Government Gazette* No. 9,597 of September 6, 1946;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be respectively the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle above which kerosene oil of the brand specified in the First Schedule hereto, shall not be sold within the area mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of my Order dated August 20, 1946, published in the *Government Gazette* No. 9,597 of September 6, 1946, shall apply as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.

KEROSENE OIL.**THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.***Order.*

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), by section 3, (read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Samson Felix Amerasinghe, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Anuradhapura District, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from January 1, 1947, my Order dated August 21, 1946, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,594 of August 30, 1946, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices of kerosene oil;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto, to be respectively the Agent's maximum price per gallon to a wholesale dealer, the maximum wholesale price per gallon to a retail dealer and the maximum retail price per bottle above which kerosene oil of any brand shall not be sold within the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that paragraphs (ii.) to (viii.) of the Order dated August 21, 1946, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,594 of August 30, 1946, regarding kerosene oil shall apply to this Order as though those paragraphs were herein incorporated.

SOAP (INDIAN).**THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.***Order.*

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I; Douglas Hastings Balfour, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date Order dated March 23, 1945, on Soap (Indian) published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,387 of March 23, 1945;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the importer's maximum price to a wholesale dealer, the maximum

wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which soap of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;

- (iii.) direct that every person who sells any soap specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such soap, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the quantity and description of the soap sold,
- (b) the price paid,
- (c) the date of the sale, and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the transaction was by wholesale or by retail;

- (iv.) direct that any trader, who, at any premises in Ceylon sells any soap of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of soap of that description.
