Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Chinnappah Coomaraswamy, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Jaffna District, do, by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this day my Food Price Order No. J. 19 of 1946, dated August 19, 1946, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,626 of November 8, 1946, in so far as it fixes maximum prices in respect of area 12 for whole wheat specified in the Schedule thereto;
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively, the Controller's maximum price per bag of 80 measures, the maximum wholesale price for bag of 80 measures and the maximum retail price per measure above which whole wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order the Controller's maximum prices should apply to the sale by the Food Controller or any persons acting on his behalf;

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Chinnappah Coomaraswamy, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Jaffna District, do by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this day my Food Price Order No. J-18 of 1946, dated August 19, 1946, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,626 of November 8, 1946, in so far as it fixes maximum prices in respect of area 12 for rice (all varieties) specified in the schedule thereto.
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto, to be respectively the Controller's maximum price per bag of 80 measures, the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures and maximum price per measure above which rice (all varieties) shall not be sold in the area mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, the Controller's maximum prices shall apply to the sale by the Food Controller or any person acting on his behalf;
- (iv.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, the provisions of paragraphs (iii.) to (vii.) of my Food Price Order No. J. 3 of 1944, dated February 19, 1944, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,240 of February 25, 1944, in respect of rice shall apply to this Order as though they were herein embodied.

BOVRIL, OXO, MARMITE AND VEGEMITE.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Revocation Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices (Food), do, by this Order revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. C—48 of 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,308 of September 1, 1944, and my Food Price Order No. C—107 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,589 of August 9, 1946, in so far as they fix maximum prices for BOVRIL, OXO, MARMITE and VEGEMITE in all parts of Ceylon.

KEROSENE OIL.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, A. S. Kohoban Wickrema, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Vavuniya District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated August 20, 1946, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,594 of August 30, 1946, relating to kerosene oil;

- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle above which kerosene oil of any brand specified at the head of columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold (by wholesale or by retail) in the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, within the Vavuniya District;
- (3) direct that every trader who sells any kerosene oil or any brand specified at the head of columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order at any premises, within the Vavuniya District shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his store or premises, a notice on which shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of that article;
- (4) direct that no such trader shall sell any kerosene oil of any brand specified at head of columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with any oil of any inferior description or quality;
- (5) direct that every person who sells kerosene oil of any brand specified at the head of columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto shall give to the purchaser of that kerosene oil a receipt in which shall be set out—
- the brand of kerosene oil sold;
 - the quantity of the kerosene oil sold;
 - the price paid;
 - the date of sale;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order a "bottle" shall be deemed to be one-sixth ($\frac{1}{6}$) of an imperial gallon;
- (7) direct that any sale of any quantity of kerosene oil less than one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle and quarter bottle only and sale of any intermediate quantity or quantities less than quarter bottle shall be prohibited;
- (8) direct that the prices shall be calculated on the bottle rate in case of sale by half or quarter bottle.
