Rescinding Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Hettiarachige Jinadasa, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) for the Island of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the Order dated November 12, 1946, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,629 of November 15, 1946, as amended by any subsequent Order, as follows:—

- (1) by the addition of the words "Made in India" after the heading "Car Tyres & Tubes" in Schedule I.;
- (2) by the addition of the words "Made in India" after the heading "Giant Tyres & Tubes" in Schedule II.;

Price Order No. J. 22/1947.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) Supplementary Provisions No. 2 Regulations, I, Philip James Hudson, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) Jaffna District do by this Order:—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this day my Price Order No. J—13 of 1945, dated July 13, 1945, in so far as they relate to maximum prices fixed for wheat flour in respect of area No. 2 in the Schedule thereto.
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively, the Controller's maximum price for 148 lbs. net, the maximum wholesale price for 148 lbs. net and the maximum retail price per lb. above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order, the provisions of paragraphs (iii.) to (vi.) of my Order dated July 13, 1945, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,435 of July 20, 1945, shall apply to this Order as though they were herein embodied.

PRESERVED MILK.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date—
- Food Price Order No. C—127 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,671 of February 21, 1947 ;
 - Food Price Order No. C—130 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,673 of February 28, 1947 ;
 - Food Price Order No. C—131 published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,676 of March 7, 1947 ;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns (4), (5), (6), (7) and (8) of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the importer's maximum price per case, the Colombo maximum wholesale price per case, the Colombo maximum retail price per tin, the outstation maximum wholesale price per case and the outstation maximum retail price per tin above which the brand of the preserved milk specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and of the net contents or size specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by wholesale or retail as the case may be ;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- "preserved milk" shall mean full cream milk imported into Ceylon which is preserved by some process and shall include powdered milk ;
 - any sale of any quantity of preserved milk for the purpose of resale or any sale of preserved milk in a quantity of one case or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
 - any sale of preserved milk in a quantity less than one case for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
 - the "importer's maximum price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale of more than two cases at a time made by an importer ;
 - the "Colombo maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale made within the Municipal limits of Colombo, except wholesale sales of more than two cases at a time made by importers ;
 - the "Colombo maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail made within the Municipal limits of Colombo ;
 - the "outstation maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale made outside the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo except wholesale sales by importers ;
 - the "Outstation maximum retail price" shall apply to all retail sales made outside the Municipal limits of Colombo ;
 - an "Importer" of any brand of preserved milk shall mean any person or firm to whom an exporter from abroad has consigned a quantity of that brand of preserved milk ;
 - a "case" of any preserved milk shall mean the quantity specified in a corresponding entry in column 3 of the schedule hereto, irrespective of whether this quantity is enclosed in a container or not ;
- (iv.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has in his possession or under his control at any place any preserved milk of the brands specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the description of that brand of preserved milk and the maximum prices therefor fixed by this Order in that area ;
- (v.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any preserved milk by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any preserved milk by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the date of sale ;
 - the quantity sold ;
 - the description and brand of the preserved milk sold ;
 - the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail ; and
 - the price paid for the quantity sold.
