THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939.

KEROSENE OIL.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Vernon Merril Peries, Assistant Controller of Prices, Puttalam-Chilaw Districts, do, by this order—

- (1) revoke with effect from April 14, 1947, the order dated January 16, 1947, made by Mr. C.J. Serasingha and published in Government Gazette No. 9,653 of January 24, 1947, fixing the maximum prices of Kerosene Oil for the Puttalam-Chilaw Districts;
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum price per fourgallon tin, the maximum price per gallon, and the maximum price per bottle above which kerosone oil of the brand specified in the corresponding entry of column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold (by wholesale or by retail) within the corresponding areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that the provisions of paragraphs (3) to (9) of my Order in respect of Kerosene Oil dated August 20, 1946, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,597 of September 6, 1946, shall apply to this order as though those paragraphs were fully incorporated in this order.

BY --- tue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, Douglas Hastings Balfour, Controllor of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do by this Order-

(i.) revoke with effect from April 14, 1947, my Order dated January 8, 1947, published in Government Gazette No. 9,649 of January 10, 1947, relating to Kerosene Oil;

(ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum price per four-gallon tin, the maximum price per gallon, and the maximum price per bottle above which kerosene oil of the brand specified in the corresponding entry of column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold (by wholesale or by retail) within the Municipal limits of Colombo; irect that paragraphs (iii) to (iii) of the Order dated

(iii.) direct that paragraphs (iii.) to (ix.) of the Order dated February 5, 1943, and published in Government Gazette No. 9,079 of February 5, 1943, regarding kerosene oil shall apply to this Order as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939. Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,054 of December 21, 1942, I, Hector Wilfred Abeyewardene, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Galle District, do, by this Order-

(1) revoke with effect from this date the Order dated January 1, 1947, published in the Government Gazette No. 9,651 of January 17, 1947;

(2) fix the prices for areas specified in column 1, of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to be respectively, the maximum price per gallon bulk and the maximum price per bottle specified in columns 3 and 4 of the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedules and column 4 of the Fifth Schedule referred to above which kerosene oil of the brands specified in column 2 of the Schedules hereto shall not be sold wholesale or by retail within the areas specified in column 1 of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules respectively;

(3) direct that every trader who exposes for sale kerosene oil of the brands specified in column 2 of the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to this Order, at any premises or from a tank-cart that hawks kerosene oil for sale within the Galle District shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises or on the tank-cart that hawks kerosene oil, for sale a notice in which shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that article;

(4) direct that no such trader or tank-carter shall sell any kerosene oil of any brand specified in column 2 of the Schedules hereto which is adulterated with any other article or any oil of an inferior description or quality ;

(5) direct that every person who sells by wholesale kerosene oil of any brand specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall, and any person who sells by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out-

(a) the brand of the kerosene oil sold,

(b) the quantity of kerosene oil sold,

(c) the price paid,

(d) the date of sale;

(6) direct that for the purpose of this order a bottle shall be

deemed to be one-sixth (1/6) of an Imperial Gallon;

(7) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to half bottle, three-quarter, and quarter bottles only, and sale of any intermediate quantity

shall be prohibited;
(8) direct that the price shall be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by three-quarter, half or quarter bottles.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) by section 3 (read with section 2(3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,054 of December 21, 1942, I, Maligawe Suraweera Berlin Fernando, Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), Ratnapura District, do by this Order-

(i.) revoke with effect from April 14, 1947, the order dated January 15, 1947, by the Assistant Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) Ratnapura District, published in Government Gazette No. 9653 of January 24, 1947, in respect of Kerosene Oil for Ratnapura District;

(ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 in the First Schedule to be the maximum price per gallon and the

schedule to be the maximum price per gallon and the maximum price per bottle, respectively, above which Kerosene Oil of all brands shall not be sold at the places specified in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the First Schedule;

(vii.) direct that every trader or tank carter who exposes for sale Kerosene Oil of any brand at any premises or from a tank cart for sale within the Ratnapura District shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at any premises or on the tank cart that hawks Kerosene Oil for sale, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by the Order be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for that article;

(viii.) direct that every person who sells by wholesale or by retail Kerosene Oil of any brand shall on demand give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out;

(a) the brand of Kerosene oil sold;

(b) the quantity of Kerosene oil sold; (c) the price paid; and (d) the date and place of sale;

(ix.) direct that for the purposes of this Order a bottle shall be deemed to be one-sixth (1/6th) of an imperial gallon

(x.) direct that sale of any quantity below one bottle shall be restricted to three-quarter bottle, half bottle and one-quarter bottle only and the sale of any

intermediate quantity shall be prohibited;

(xi.) direct that the price shall be calculated in the case of sale by half-gallon from tank carts at the gallon rate and be calculated on the bottle rate in the case of sale by three-quarter, half and one-quarter bottles
