THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939. Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulier, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. C—63, published in Government Gazette No. 9,435 of July 20, 1945, in so far it fixes maximum prices for the preserved milk and the milk food of the des-
- for the preserved milk and the milk food of the descriptions and brands specified in column 1 of the Schedules 1 and 2 hereto;

 (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedules 1 and 2 hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per case, and the maximum retail price per tin above which the brand of preserved milk or milk food specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of those Schedules and of the standard prock specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 pack specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of those Schedules shall not be sold by wholesale or by

retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon;

(iii.) direct that paragraphs (iii.) to (v.) of my Food Price

Order No. C-63, published in Government Gazette

No. 9,435 of July 20, 1945, shall apply to this Order

PRESERVED MILK.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defonce (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reguald Sydney Vernon Poulier, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order-

(i.) fix the prices specified in columns (4), (5), (6), (7) and (8) of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the importer's maximum price per case, the Colombo maximum wholesale price per case, the Colombo maximum retail price per tin, the outstation maximum wholesale price per case and the outstation maximum retail price per tin above which the brand of the preserved milk specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and of the not contents or size specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule heroto, shall not be sold by wholesale or retail as the case may be; (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) "preserved milk" shall mean full cream milk imported into Ceylon which is preserved by some process and shall include powdered milk;
- (b) any sale of any quantity of preserved milk for the purpose of resale or any sale of preserved milk in a quantity of one case or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 (c) any sale of preserved milk in a quantity less than one case for the purpose of consumption or use shall be

deemed to be a sale by retail;
(d) the "importor's maximum price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale of more than two cases at a time

made by an importor;

(c) the "Colombo maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale made within the Municipal limits of Colombo, except wholesale sales of more than two cases at a time made by importers;

(f) the "Colombo maximum rotail price" shall apply to all sales by retail made outside the Municipal limits

of Colombo; (g) the "Outstation maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale made outside the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo except wholesale sales by importers;

(h) the "Outstation maximum retail price" shall apply to all retail sales made outside the Municipal limits

of Colombo;
(i) an "Importor" of any brand of preserved milk shall mean any person or firm to whom an exporter from

abroad has consigned a quantity of that brand of preserved milk;
(j) a "case" of any preserved milk shall mean the quantity specified in a corresponding entry in column 3

of the Schedule hereto, irrespective of whether this quantity is enclosed in a container or not; (iii.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has in his possession or under his control at any place any preserved milk of the brands specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto

shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the description of that brand of preserved milk and the maximum prices therefor fixed by this Order in that area; (iv.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any preserved

milk by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any preserved milk by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out-

(a) the date of sale;

(b) the quantity sold;

the description and brand of the preserved milk sold;

(d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail; and

(e) the price paid for the quantity sold.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulier, Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order -

(i.) fix the prices specified in columns 4 and 5 of the schedule herto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per case, and the maximum retail price per tin above which the brand of preserved milk specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that schedule and of the net contents or size specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that schedule shall not be sole by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Cevlon:

(ii.) direct that paragraphs (iii.) to (v.) of my Food Price Order No. C-63 relating to preserved milk and milk foods, published in Government Gazette No. 9,435, shall apply in the case of the preserved milk of the description specified in column 1 of the schedule herete as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.
