A fee determined in accordance with the rates specified in the Schedule hereto shall be payable in respect of the examination and consideration of plans submitted under the provisions of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance (Chapter 199) for new buildings or for alterations to existing buildings.
- 2. (1) The amount of the fee payable under by law 1 shall be paid by the person making the application for approval or consent within seven days from the date of receipt of a demand from the Municipal Commissioner.

 (2) Every person who fails to pay such fee within the period

(2) Every person who fails to pay such fee within the period prescribed in the preceding paragraph of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be hable to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees.

3. Notwithstanding anything in section 9 of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance, no plan shall be examined and considered until the fee referred to in by-law 1 is paid.
