THE ENTERTAINMENT TAX ORDINANCE, No. 12 OF 1946.

THE following resolution passed by the Vavuniya Town Council under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, has been approved by the Executive Committee of Local Administration and is published in terms of sub-section (2) of that section:—

Resolution.

“ This Council, under sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance, No. 12 of 1946, hereby imposes and levies, with effect from the first day of May, 1947, a tax at the rates set out hereunder on payments for admission to entertainments (as defined in the Ordinance) held in the area within the administrative limits of the Council.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE.

Post of Head Overseer, D. R. C., Kandy.

APPLICATIONS are invited by the Local Government Service Commission for the above post.

2. The salary attached to the post is Rs. 1,200 per annum rising by eleven annual increments of Rs. 72 to Rs. 1,992 per annum. A rent allowance and a temporary war allowance at Government rates will be paid. No special temporary allowance will be paid.

3. Applicants should be not less than 25 nor more than 35 years of age on May 29, 1947, and should have passed the Junior School Certificate (English) Examination or a higher examination. They should also possess—

- (1) a good practical knowledge of surveying, levelling and tracing of roads,
- (2) must be able to design and draw plans and take out quantities for estimating purposes,
- (3) practical experience in supervision of construction of bridges, buildings, improvements and maintenance of roads,
- (4) more than 5 years experience in supervising work and a certificate from the Ceylon Technical College in Elementary Building Construction and Draughtsmanship.

4. Applications will also be considered from those holding permanent posts in Government service or in the Local Government Service irrespective of age and academic qualifications, provided they are otherwise qualified. Applications from such candidates should be forwarded through the Head of the Department or the Chairman or Commissioner of the Local Body.

5. The Commission reserves to itself the right to appoint a candidate who is above the age limit if he is found suitable and otherwise qualified.

6. The selected candidate will be on one year's probation and will be subject to the provisions of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No. 43 of 1945, and any regulations made thereunder.

7. Applications in the candidates own handwriting, stating age, academic qualifications, and full particulars of experience, together with copies only of certificates and testimonials, should reach the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, P. O. Box 530, Colombo, not later than 12 noon on May 29, 1947.
