THE REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE.

Order under section 2.

WHEREAS I, John Curtois Howard, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, have, during the present session of the State Council, approved of the introduction in that Council of a resolution whereby, if such resolution be carried, export duties shall be imposed on certain goods exempt from duty which are specified in the Schedule hereto and export duties payable on certain other goods which are specified in that Schedule shall be altered :

Cap. 191. Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Revenue Protection Ordinance, I do hereby order the Principal Collector of Customs from midnight of the twenty-seventh day of January, 1947, to demand and levy on the goods severally specified in Column I of that Schedule the export duties set out in the corresponding entries in Column II of that Schedule, in addition to any export duties which may be leviable or payable on any of those goods under any written law (other than the Customs Ordinance, the Medical Wants Ordinance, and the Export Duties (Continuation of Increased Rates Ordinance, No. 9 of 1945) :

Cap. 176.

Provided that export duty on any tea, which is certified under the hand of the Tea Commissioner—

(a) to have been sold at either of the public auction sales of tea organised by the Colombo Tea Traders' Association and conducted at the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce Sales Room on the twentieth day and the twenty-seventh day of January, 1947 ; or

(b) to have been manufactured prior to the first day of January, 1947, and purchased by the Tea Commissioner on behalf of the United Kingdom Ministry of Food,

shall be leviable and payable at the rate applicable prior to midnight of the twenty-seventh day of January, 1947.
