A PROCLAMATION.

HENRY MOORE.

KNOW Ye that by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 30 of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance (Chapter 94), I, Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation—

- (a) amend the Proclamation under the said section, dated September 12, 1935, and published in the Supplement to Gazette No. 8,146 of September 20, 1935, in the manner set out in the Schedule hereto; and
- (b) declare that this Proclamation shall come into effect on the first day of April, 1947.

Schedule I to the Proclamation dated September 12, 1935, and published in the Supplement to Gazette No. 8,146 of September 20, 1935, is hereby amended, by the substitution, for the definition of Rambukkana Town in the Kegalle District of the Sabaragamuwa Province, therein appearing and reproduced in Column I., of the definition appearing in Column II. hereunder-

Column I.

Limits as defined by Proclamation, dated September 12, 1935.

Rambukkana Town comprising the area within the following boundaries :-

North: Rambukkana-oya, village boundary between Diyasunnata and Werellapota, and village boundary between Werellapota and Kamburadeniya.

Village boundaries of Kudagama, Kurempola, and Pinnawala.

East: Village boundary between Godagandeniya and Kamburadeniya, the village boundary between Beligoda-pitiya and Kamburadeniya, the village boundary between Beligodapitiya and Pallemadawala, and the village boundary between Udamadawala and Beligodapitiya.

West: Maha-oya and Rambukkana-oya

Column II.

Limits as defined by this Proclamation.

Rambukkana Town comprising the area within the following boundaries :-

North: By a line drawn from a point at the centre of the Rambukkan-oya where the Walaru-oya meets it, north-eastwards along the centre of the Rambukkanoya to the western village limit of Werellapota (F. V. P. 105), thence by a line drawn south-eastwards and north-eastwards along the western and southern limits of the said village till it meets the western village limit of Godagandeniya (F. V. P. 162).

East: By a line drawn from the last mentioned point southeastwards along the western village limit of Godagandeniya (F. V. P. 162) till it meets the northern village limit of Beligodapitiya, thence by a line drawn south-westwards and southwards along the northern and western limits of the said village to the northern village limit of Pinnawala.

South: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwestwards and north-westwards along the northern village limit of Pinnawala, the eastern and northern village limits of Kurempola (F. V. P. 113), the northern village limit of Kudagama (F. V. P. 112) and the southern and eastern village limits of Hurimaluwa (F. V. P. 111) to the centre of the railway line from Colombo to Kandy, thence by a line drawn westwards along the centre of the said railway line to the centre of the railway bridge at the confluence of the Rambukkan-oya and the Maha-oya. kan-oya and the Maha-oya.

West: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards along the centre of the Rambukkan-oya to the starting point of the northern limit of the area.

THE CENNAMON EXPORTS (LEVY OF CESS) ORDINANCE, No. 1 of 1947.

Order.

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Cinnamon Exports (Levy of Cess) Ordinance, No. 1 of 1947, I, Oliver Ernest Goonetilleke, Financial Secretary, on the recommendation of the Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do hereby impose an export duty at the rate of 20 cents per pound on all grades of cinnamon (other than featherings and chips) exported from Ceylon.

This Order shall come into force at midnight on the twentieth day of February, 1947.
