THE CEYLON (PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946.

Electoral District No. 9—Atkaragalla.

NOTICE is hereby given under section 11 (2) of the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946, that the first Register of Electors for the above Electoral District has been completed and that such register is open for inspection at the Colombo Kacheheri during office hours.

Every person who was on the 22nd May, 1946, qualified in accordance with the Ceylon (State Council Elections) Order in Council, 1931, to have his name entered in a register of Voters and whose name has been omitted from the register of electors now completed and who claims to have it inserted therein must submit a written claim to the Registering Officer, Colombo Kacheheri.

No person is entitled to claim to have his name inserted in the said register on the ground that he is qualified under Article 8 or under Article 9 of the Ceylon (State Council Elections) Order in Council, 1931, unless an application made by him in accordance with the requirements of Article 14 was duly received by the said Registering Officer on or before the 1st day of July, 1946.

Every person whose name appears in the register now completed who objects to the inclusion in such register of his own name or the name of any other person appearing therein or to the insertion in such register of the name of any person who has claimed to have his name inserted therein, must submit a written objection to the said Registering Officer.

Every claim must be in Form C and every objection must be in Form D or Form E in the First Schedule to the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946. Copies of these forms are obtainable from the said Registering Officer.

Every claim and every objection to the inclusion of a name in the register must reach the said Registering Officer within two weeks from the date of the publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*. Every objection to the

insertion in the register of the name of a claimant must reach the said Registering Officer within ten days from the date on which a notice containing the names of claimants is exhibited at the office of the said Registering Officer.

NOTICE is hereby given under Section 11 (2) of the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946, that the first Register of Electors for each of the above Electoral Districts has been completed and that such register is open for inspection at the Galle Kachcheri during office hours.

Portions of the register relating to those areas are also available for inspection at Post Offices, Sub Post Offices, Divisional Revenue Officers' Offices and the Offices of the Village Headmen.

Every person who was on May 22, 1946, qualified in accordance with the Ceylon (State Council Elections) Order in Council, 1931, to have his name entered in a register of voters and whose name has been omitted from any of the registers of electors now completed and who claims to have it inserted therein must submit a written claim to the Registering Officer, Galle Kachcheri.

No person is entitled to claim to have his name inserted in any of the said registers on the ground that he is qualified under Article 8 or under Article 9 of the Ceylon (State Council Elections) Order in Council, 1931, unless an application made by him in accordance with the requirements of Article 14 was duly received by the said Registering Officer on or before July 1, 1946.

Every person whose name appears in any of the registers now completed who objects to the inclusion in such register of his own name or the name of any other person appearing therein or to the insertion in such register of the name of any person who has claimed to have his name inserted therein, must submit a written objection to the said Registering Officer.

Every claim must be in Form C and every objection must be in Form D or Form E in the First Schedule to the Ceylon (Parliamentary Elections) Order in Council, 1946. Copies of these forms are obtainable from the said Registering Officer.
