It is ordered that 4th respondent be and he is hereby appointed guardian ad litem over the 1st to 3rd minor respondents, for the purpose of these proceedings, unless the respondents shall, on or before June 11, 1948, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.

It is ordered that the said petitioner be and he is hereby declared entitled, as widower of the above-named deceased, to have letters of administration to her estate issued to him, unless the respondents or any other person or persons interested

unless the respondents or any other person or persons interested shall, on or before June 11, 1948, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
