WHEAT FLOUR.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN ME BY SECTION 3, READ WITH SECTION 2 (3) OF THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939, AS AMENDED BY DEFENCE (CONTROL OF PRICES) (SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS NO. 2) REGULATIONS, I, E. FORBES, ACTING DEPUTY CONTROLLER OF PRICES (FOOD) FOR THE MATARA DISTRICT, DO BY THIS ORDER—

(i) revoke with effect from this date the Order of the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) for the Matara District, dated February 2, 1948, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,833 of February 13, 1948, in so far as it fixes maximum prices of wheat flour for the Matara District;

(ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the schedule hereto to be, respectively the maximum wholesale price per 148 lb. net, and the maximum retail price per pound above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the schedule hereto;

(iii) direct that for the purpose of this order—

(a) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be sale by wholesale;

(b) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be sale by retail;

(iv) direct that in every case where maximum prices are fixed by this order no person shall sell any wheat flour which is adulterated with any article;

(v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order every trader who has any wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this order in that area;

(vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order every person who sells any flour by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any wheat flour by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—

(a) the date of sale;

(b) the weight of wheat flour sold;

(c) the prices paid for the quantity of wheat flour sold;

(d) the nature of the transaction, *i.e.*, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

WHEAT FLOUR.THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939.
Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Philip James Hudson, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Jaffna District, do, by this order:—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this day my Food Price Order No. J. 1/1948 dated February 2, 1948, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,833 of March 13, 1948, in so far as it fixes maximum prices of wheat flour in the Jaffna District.
- (ii.) fix the prices for wheat flour specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively, the Controller's maximum price for 148 pounds nett, the maximum wholesale price per 148 pounds nett and the maximum retail price per pound above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that for the purposes of this order, the provisions of paragraphs (iii.) to (vi.) of my price order No. J 1/1948 dated February 2, 1948, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,833 of February 13, 1948, in respect of wheat flour shall apply to this order as though they were herein embodied.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, William Holmes, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) for the Province of Uva, do by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date Food Price Order No. BD 10 dated October 8, 1947, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,789 of October 17, 1947, and Food Price Order No. BD 11, dated February 2, 1948, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,830 of February 6, 1948, in so far as they relate to the maximum wholesale and retail prices of wheat flour;
- (2) fix the prices specified in Columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price for 148 lb. net and the maximum retail price per pound, above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that for the purpose of this order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (4) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order every trader, who has any wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (5) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any wheat flour which is adulterated with any other articles;
- (6) direct that in every area where the maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who sells any wheat flour, by wholesale, shall, and every person who sells any wheat flour by retail shall on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the weight of the wheat flour sold;
 - (c) the price paid for the weight of wheat flour sold;
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, i. e., whether the sale was by wholesale or retail.

WHEAT FLOUR.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939.
Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Richard Henry David Manders, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) for the North-Central Province, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated April 30, 1948, in respect of Wheat Flour and Wheat Flour (Bakeries), published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,860 of May 7, 1948, in so far as it fixes maximum prices of Wheat Flour for the North-Central Province;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per 148 lb. net and the maximum retail price per lb. above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that for the purposes of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of Wheat Flour for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of Wheat Flour for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser, shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any Wheat Flour which is adulterated with any article;
 - (d) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any Wheat Flour in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
 - (e) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any Wheat Flour by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any Wheat Flour by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the weight of the Wheat Flour sold;
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity of Wheat Flour sold;
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, *i.e.* whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
