RICE.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, N. Q. Dias, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for the Matara District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date the Order of the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Matara District, dated September 28, 1944, and published in Government Gazette No. 9,319 of October 13, 1944;
 (2) revoke with effect from this date the Order of the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Matara District, dated November 17, 1944, and published in Government Gazette No. 9,335 of November 24, 1944,
 (3) fix the maximum wholesale price which is for the time being fixed by me at the Supply Stations as shown in the Second Schedule hereto increased by the amounts specified in columns 2, 3, 4, or 5 (as the case may be) of the First Schedule hereto as the maximum wholesale price per bag above which rice shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto,
 (4) direct that every trader who sells rice shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique) a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for rice.

- notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for rice, direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article, direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale,

 - (b) the quantity of rice sold,
 (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold,
 (d) the nature of the transaction that the sale was wholesale,
- (7) direct that for the purpose of this Order-

 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
 (b) 'measure' shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure; and
 (c) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures fixed by this

WHEAT FLOUR.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 of 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Mailvaganam Srikhanta, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for the Puttalam and Chilaw Districts do by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date the Order dated February 2, 1948, published in Government Gazette No. 9,830 of February 6, 1948, in so far as it fixes maximum prices of wheat flour for the Puttalam and Chilaw Districts.
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per 148 lb. net and the maximum retail price per pound above which wheat flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries, in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;
- (iii.) direct that for the purposes of this Order:-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of consumption by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any wheat flour which is adulterated with any article;
- (v.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vi.) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sell any wheat flour by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any wheat flour by retail shall on demand give the

purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out :—-

(a) the date of sale;

(b) the weight of the wheat flour sold;

- (c) the price paid for the quantity of wheat flour sold;
- (d) the nature of the transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or retail.

(1) revoke with effect from July 19, 1948, my Order dated September 13, 1944, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,312 of September 22, 1944, fixing the maximum wholesale and retail prices above which rice shall not be sold within Puttalam-Chilaw Districts, in so

far as it relates to the wholesale prices of rice;
(2) fix with effect from July 19, 1948, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures and per bag of 112 measures above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule;

(3) direct that the paragraphs 4 to 6 of my Order on rice dated October 22, 1943, and published in Government Gazette No. 9,187 of October 29, 1943, shall apply to this Order as though these paragraphs were fully incorporated in this Order.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939. Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Stewart Murray Duff, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Kalutara District, do by this Order:—

(1) revoke with effect from this date the Orders dated November 3, 1945, and November 24, 1947, and published in *Government Gazettes* Nos. 9,483 of 9.483 of November 9, 1945, and 9,806 of December 5, 1947, respectively, in so far as they relate to the maximum wholesale and retail prices of rice fixed in respect of the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule attached hereto;

(2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale prices per bag and the maximum retail prices per measure above which rice shall not be sold in the areas specified in the corresponding entries column I of the Schedule hereto;

(3) direct that every trader who sells rice in any area specified in column I of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous place at his premises (store or boutique) a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for that area;

- (4) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article;
- (5) direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale or by retail shall on demand give the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out:—
 - (a) the date of the sale;

 - (b) the quantity of rice sold;(c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold;
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail:
- (6) direct that for the purposes of this Order :-
 - (a) a bag of rice including raw rice shall contain 80
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (c) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (d) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure.
 - (e) the maximum price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is more or less than one bag or one measure, as the case may be, shall be determined by reference to maximum price per bag or measure fixed by this Order;
 - (f) the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall not include the price of the container in which the rice is sold.
