THE HOUSING AND TOWN IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE.

THE following resolution passed by the Senate at a meeting held on March 2, 1948, and by the House of Representatives at a meeting held on May 18, 1948, is published for general information:—

This House resolves under the provisions of section 3 (b) of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance (Chapter 199), as modified by Proclamation under section 88 (1) of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, that from the 1st day of March, 1948, the aforesaid Ordinance shall be in force within the area defined in the schedule hereto:—

Schedule.

All that area of land representing the former Sanitary Board town of Waga situated in Kahahena village in Udugaha pattuwa of Hewagam korale in the Colombo District, Western Province, and bounded as follows:—

North: By a line drawn from a point on the southern boundary of Hatanliyadda claimed by I. D. Sugathadasa 2 chains 20 links north of the centre of Kaluaggala-Labugama P. W. D. road measured along the said boundary north-eastwards along the southern boundary of the said land, south-eastwards and northwards along the southern and eastern boundaries of Edanupitiyakumbura claimed by Hendrick Wickramaarachchi and others, northwards and eastwards along the eastern boundary of Koswele-wattekumbura claimed by W. D. Saranelis and others, south-eastwards along the southern boundary of Evariyamullawala claimed by I. D. C. Wijeratna and others, eastwards and south-eastwards along the southern boundary of Bogahawatta claimed by K. P. Perera and others to the northern end of the culvert across the Railway Line, thence by a line drawn south-eastwards along the said culvert, through Godandawatta claimed by K. S. Perera and others, Kekunugahalanda claimed by D. S. Ranasinghe and others and S. D. Emis Weeratunga and others to the southern boundary of Gorakagahawatta claimed by A. Aga Fernando and others, thence by a line drawn south-eastwards along the said boundary to a point 50 links north of the Gansabhawa road leading to Kosgama at its bend.

East: By a lime drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards along the said southern boundary of Gorakagahawatta to the centre of the Gansabhawa road leading to Kosgama and across to its eastern boundary, southwards along the eastern boundary of the said road to the western boundary of Polkandakumbura claimed by I. D. Sman Appuhamy and others, thence by a line drawn southwards along the western boundary of the said land to the centre of culvert No. 3/5 across the Kaluaggala-Labugama Public Works Department road.

South: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point westwards across the culvert No. 3/5, and along the northern boundary of Halgahakumbura claimed by W. M. Carolis Appu and others, westwards and southwestwards along the northern and western boundaries of Kahatagahalanda claimed by I. D. Daniel Appuhamy and others to the south-western corner of the said land, thence by a line drawn north-westwards

through Kahatagahalanda claimed by D. P. R. Goonewardena and others to a distance of 450 links bearing 317° 45′, through Ellebodalanda claimed by I. D. Abraham and others and K. Ginoris Fernando and others, by a line 310 links in length bearing 291° 30′, by a line 270 links in length bearing 283° 30′ and by a line 360 links in length bearing 286° 30′, thence by a line drawn westwards through Ellebodalanda claimed by K. Ginoris Fernando and others to a point on the Railway line 3 chains 45 links south of the south-eastern corner of Alubogalaudeniya claimed by D. J. R. Gunawardena and others.

West: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards through Ellebodalanda claimed by Hendrick and others to the south-eastern corner of Alubogahadeniya claimed by D. J. R. Gunawardena and others, thence northwards along the eastern boundary of the said land across the Kaluaggala-Labugama Public Works Department road and along the southern boundary of Hatanliyadda claimed by I. D. Sugathadasa and others to the starting point of the northern limit of the area.
