Local Government Clerical Service Examination.

Date of Examination.

A competitive examination for male candidates wishing to enter Grade II of the Local Government Clerical Service will be held in Colombo, Kandy, Galle and Jaffna on October The examination will be conducted by the Director of-Education.

(1) Salary.—Successful candidates will be appointed as vacancies occur to posts in Grado II of the Local Government Clerical Service to serve Local Authorities (other than Village Ciercal Service to serve Local Authorities (other than Village Committees) on the salary of Rs. 840 per annum rising by annual increments of Rs. 72 to Rs. 2,424 per annum. In this scale efficiency bars operate before Rs. 1,488 and Rs. 2,064 per annum. Rent allowance and a temporary cost of living allowance will be payable.

(ii) Conditions of Service.—(a) The grant of leave and other conditions will be governed by the by-laws and regulations of the local authority, subject to the provisions of the

- tions of the local authority subject to the provisions of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No. 43 of 1945, and any regulations framed thereunder.

 (b) Successful candidates will be appointed on two years' probation. Those appointed to a Local Authority (other than a Municipal Council) will be liable to transfer within an area specified in the Second Schedule to the above Ordinance, and may be posted to any station within the specified an area specified in the Second Schedule to the above Ordinance, and may be posted to any station within the specified area in Ceylon. They will be required to pass a test in type-writing within one year of the date of appointment and no increment of salary will be given until the test is passed. They will be subject to the provisions of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No. 43 of 1945, as amended by the Local Government Service (Transitional Provisions) Ordinance, No. 5 of 1946, any further amendments of Ordinance No. 43 of 1945, and any regulations made thereunder.
- (c) Successful candidates with previous continuous service in a Local Authority or under the Ceylon Government may be allowed incremental credit for such service.
- 3. The names of successful candidates will be published in the Ceylon Government Gazette, and they will be given appointments as suitable vacancies occur.

together with either (i) the Higher Commercial Certificate Examination (either section) of the London Chamber of Commerce or (11) the Commercial Certificate Examination (either section) of the London Chamber of Commerce.

- (iv) Candidates must be within the age limits laid down in paragraph 6 (iv) except that Service candidates may deduct the period of their mobilized service in the

 - (ii) Candidates who are already employed in Government Departments or under Local Authorities, whether n a permanent or temporary capacity, must forward their applications through the Heads of the Departments or the Chairman of the Local Authorities in which they are serving. If any candidate fails to do so, he will be regarded as disqualified.

- certificate of the registration of the candidate's birth showing him to have been born not earlier than September 1, 1923, and not later than September 1, 1931, must be attached to the form of application.
- -(a) Affidavits will not ordinarily be accepted as substitutes for birth certificates.
- (b) A certified copy of a birth registration entry effected more than one year after the date of the birth, under section 18 (1) (b) of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance (Cap. 94), will be accepted only after consideration of the evidence by which the date of birth was established. Where the name appearing in the birth certificate differs from the name which the candidate ordinarily uses, satisfactory evidence will have to be adduced that the birth certificate is that of the candidate and not that of any other person. Where the candidate is under 21 years of age or is more than 21 years of age and has a parent living, application should be made to the Registrar-General's or to the Provincial Regis-trar's or Assistant Provincial Registrar's Office in the district in which the birth took place under

section 19 of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance for the amendment of the entry in cage 2 of the birth registration entry, and in other cases application should be made to the District Court under section 20 for rectification of the entry in cage 2.

(v) A certificate of good character signed by a responsible person to the satisfaction of the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, must also be a attached to the form of application. If the candidate has been educated at a Government or Assisted School, the certificate of character must be from the Principal of the last Government or Assisted School which he has attended; otherwise it may be from the candidate's teacher or school-master by preference, or a member of the Public Service, a Justice of the Peace, Minister of Religion, Advocate, Proctor or Notary or generally speaking some person whose name is known and to whom reference

can be readily made.

(vi) The Chairman, Local Government Sorvice Commission will issue admission forms to those candidates whose applications are accepted. Candidates presenting themselves for examination must produce to the officer appointed to supervise the examination their forms of admission. A candidate not produce reads forms of admission. ducing such form will be refused admittance

Candidates must sit for the examination at the Examination hall assigned to them. A candidate presenting himself at an examination hall other than the one assigned to him will be refused admission to the examination.

A copy of the time table and the rules for the guidance of candidates for the examination will be forwarded together with the admission form. These should be read carefully by candidates. Every candidate presenting himself for the examination must give up his admission form to the Supervising Examiner on the day of the examination.

If a candidate does not receive his admission form at least seven days before the day of the examination he should communicate without delay with the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, informing him that he has not received the admission form and giving the following particulars:—

(I) Name of Examination,

(2) Full name,

Full Postal Address,

(4) Examination Centre at which candidate applied to take his examination.

Should any of the particulars furnished by candidates, be found to be false within their knowledge, they will, if appointed, be liable to be dismissed. The wilful suppression of any material fact will be similarly penalised.

Withdrawals and Refunds .-

(a) If a candidate is rejected owing to his not satisfying the conditions for admission to the examination a refund will be made of 3/5ths the value of the examination fee of Rs. 5.

(b) If a candidate, who has been admitted to the examination gives notice of his withdrawal to the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission at least 7 days before the date of the examination, a refund will be made of half the value of the examination fee. In case the form of admission to the examination has reached the candidate it should be returned to the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, for a refund.

(c) A candidate, who has been admitted to the examination and wishes to withdraw on account of illness, should forward notice of his withdrawal together with his admission form to the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, by registered post at least one day before the examination. A refund of the full examination fee will then be made, provided his notice of withdrawal is accompanied by a certificate from a qualified medical practitioner to the effect that he is unfit to sit for the examination.

(d) In no other case will a refund be granted.

Leave to Officers to attend Examination .-

9. Heads of Departments and Chairmen of Local Authorities are kindly requested to grant to officers of their Departments and of Local Bodies whose applications have been approved by the Chairman, Local Government Service Commission, leave to present themselves at the examination.

Sinhalese must be taken by Sinhalese candidates and Tamil by Tamil candidates. Candidates who are neither Sinhalese nor Tamil will be given the option of taking Sinhalese or Tamil or Arabic or a Special Paper in English, but candidates of mixed parentage must offer the language of one of their parents within the group English (Special), Sinhalese, Tamil or Arabic. Marks.

(4) Vira Vocc Test.—Candidates are required to produce at the viva vocc test the original certificates granted to them in respect of the examinations they have passed which qualify them for admission to the Local Government

The examination is held in two parts. The written examination is first held and on the results of it candidates are selected competitively to attend the Viva Voce. number to be called at the viva voce Examination will be fixed by the Local Government Service Commission in consultation with the Director of Education. In all written papers marks will be deducted for bad handwriting and mistakes in spelling. Candidates, whose writing is illegible are hable to be disquilarfied. The viva voce examination will be held in Colombo.
