



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"Improvements in or relating to the processing of natural rubber".

Abstract.-The inventor states that rubber for shipment has to be subjected to prolonged drying, e.g., for 24 hours in

order to drive out as much moisture as possible. He advocates the intensified drying of the rubber in a current of hot air at a temperature between $130^{\circ}F$ and $180^{\circ}F$ and then masticating in a rubber mixing machine, *e.g.* a Banbury mixture. The heat generated in this process effectively completes the drying. The rubber could finally be rolled out.
