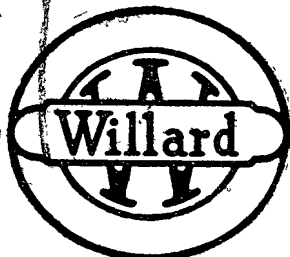

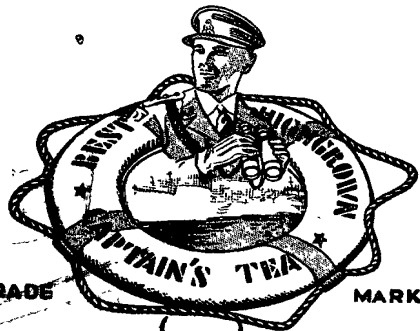

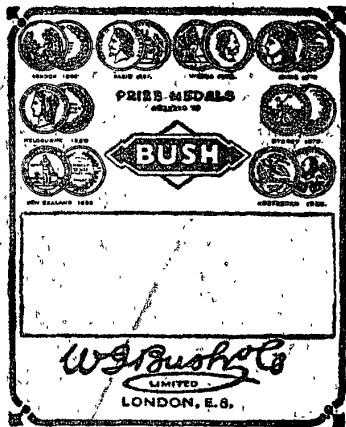

"Improvements relating to the reconditioning of pneumatic tyres".

Abstract.—The object of this invention is to economise apparatus in retreading tyres of different sizes. According to the invention the tyre is held between two shoulder plates and an annular tread ring. The same pair of shoulder plates can be used with different tread rings for different sizes. The shoulder plates have conical surfaces which converge towards the tread ring when the three are filled together.

There are 10 claims and 3 sheets of drawings.
