"Improvements in apparatus for rolling Tea Leaf".

Abstract.—The inventors describe a continuous rolling machine for tea leaf comprising a tubular casing adapted to receive the tea leaf at one end and discharge it at the other and a roller within the casing and substantially co-axial therein, the arrangement being such that the said casing or roller or both are capable of rotation and one or both ends of such roller or of casing are capable of being thrown out of centre.

A disclaimer has been entered by the applicants as follows:—Neither the claims nor the specification refer to rolling machines in which the casing is moved in an oscillating manner by crank operated mechanism.


