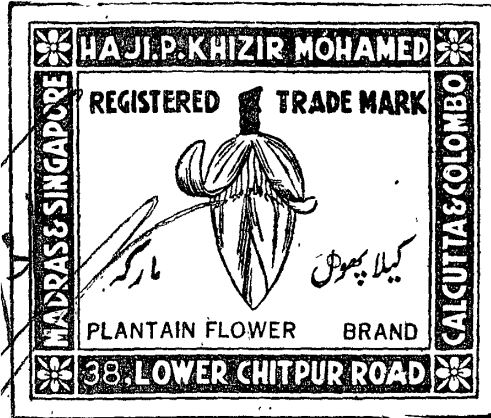

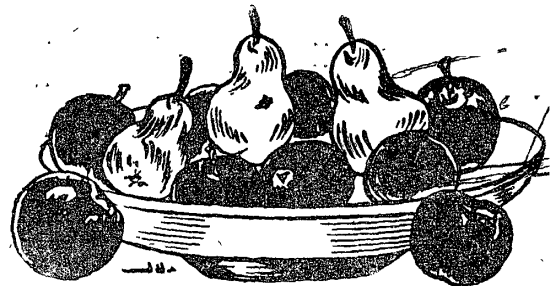

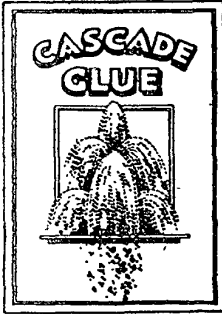

The effect is to raise the rollers a slight distance from the bottom of the spaces between the teeth and thus keep the chain taut and eliminate noise.

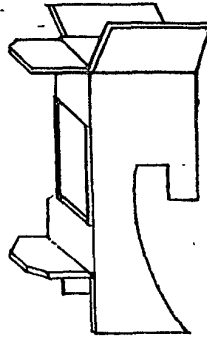

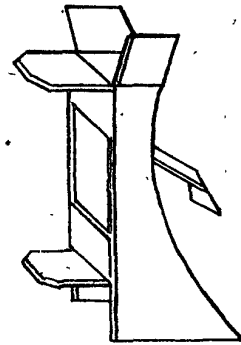
