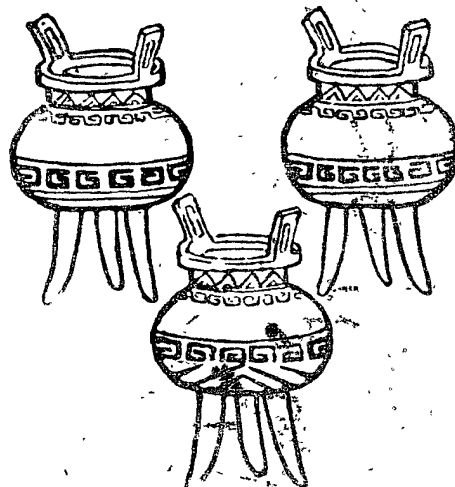

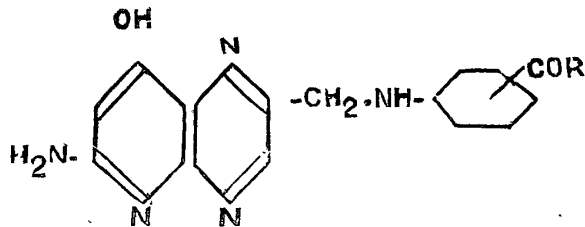

"Improvements in or relating to the preparation of pterins".

Abstract.—The invention relates to the preparation of pterins having, in at least one tautomeric form, the formula



wherein R is OR' or NR' R', R' and R'' being hydrogen, aromatic or aliphatic radicals, which method comprises admixing

- (i) 2, 4, 5-triamino-6-hydroxypyrimidine or a tautomer thereof;
- (ii) a 1, 1, 3-trihaloacetone;
- (iii) an aminobenzoic acid or a salt, ester or amide thereof.

All three reactants may be admixed simultaneously; or alternatively reactants (i) and (ii) may be mixed and the reactant product mixed with (iii); or alternatively (ii) and (iii) may be mixed and the reactant added to (i).

There are 11 claims.

"Improvements in or relating to appliances for cutting and gathering leaves, grasses, herbs and so forth".

Abstract.—The inventor describes a machine comprising a stationary horizontal cutter, a reciprocating cutter, a rotary member provided with flexible blades, and a hopper. The whole mechanism is driven by an electric motor in such a way

that the material to be cut is fed to the cutters by the rotating blades, and after being cut are swept with the hopper.

"Method of adhesively uniting materials, adhesives therefor, as well as articles united therewith".

Abstract.—The invention relates to improvements to the inventions described in Ceylon Patent Specification Nos. 3,404 and 3,481. According to the earlier inventions the metals to be united had to be heated after the application of the adhesive. In the present invention hardening takes place at room temperature. The adhesive mixture comprises a resinous ethylene oxide derivative of a phenol, containing at least two ethylene oxide groups, a non volatile solvent for the ethylene oxide derivative, and a liquid hardening agent.

"Improvements in lacquers".

Abstract.—The inventors claim a process for making a raw material for lacquers, especially baking lacquers, from resinous ethylene oxide derivatives of phenols wherein such a resinous ethylene derivative containing at least two ethylene oxide groups is treated in the presence of a suitable solvent with dicyandiamide and an aldehyde condensation product containing etherified methylol groups and if desired a poly-valent phenol is added at any stage of the process.

There are 18 claims and 18 examples.
