NOTIFICATIONS UNDER "THE PATENTS ORDINANCE, 1906."

THE following specification has been accepted:—

No. 3,495 of October 22, 1947.

John Costa Gonsalves.

"A set of cover to save rubber latex from rain".

Abstract.—A piece of jute is liberally treated with powdered chalk or clay and waterproof paste No. 1 and passed between smooth rollers. A further coating of paste and colouring matter is followed by a further rolling. This sheet is then cut into ribbons and squares. The ribbons are corrugated and stuck to the tree by waterproof paste No. 2 so as to form a roof over the tapping panel. The latex cup and spout are protected by a square mat which is tied by one corner to the spout with the other corners hanging down over the cup.

Cloth treated with paste No. 1 and colouring matter can be used instead of jute. The cloth ribbon is hemstitched on one side for passing a ribbon for tying round the tree after the application of paste No. 2.

The ingredients of paste No. 1 are rosin, turpentine and rubber latex. Paste No. 2 is a compound of crepe rubber, turpentine and rosin. The method of making the pastes are described and claimed.

There are 5 claims and 1 sheet of drawings.
