#### NOTIFICATIONS UNDER "THE PATENTS ORDINANCE, 1908."

THE following specifications have been accepted:—

No. 3,493 of October 9, 1947.

"Improvements in half round tiles".

*Abstract.*—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1, 2 and 3 which are as follows:—

(1) A half round tile rebated at the outer periphery of the lower end, and made of clay, cement, or any suitable material.

(2) In a half round tile the broad end of which admits the rebated narrow end to lap into the said broad end to a pre-determined position.

(3) In a half round tile the flanges of which are tapered so as to permit the narrow end to enter the broad end of the next tile, and to prevent the said broad end of the cover tile resting on the narrow end of the connecting tile.

Imperial Chemical Industries, Ltd.

"Improvements in the manufacture of furfural".

*Abstract.*—The inventor describes a process for the production of furfural which comprises subjecting pentosan-containing vegetable raw material such as cereal husks, cotton-seed hulls, maize cobs and stalks, bagasse, wood, straw, coconut shell or palm-kernel shell in non-finely divided form, and without agitation, to heat and pressure in a stationary reaction vessel, together with an aqueous liquid in an amount such that under reaction conditions all or substantially all of the said liquid is absorbed by the material, and passing steam through the reaction mass to remove the furfural. A quantity of salt or strong mineral acid may be added to the reaction mixture.

There are 8 examples and 26 claims.
