



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

"Production of aerosols".

Abstract:—The inventors state that insecticidal and germicidal compounds which can be volatilised without decomposition are more highly effective in the form of aerosols than in the form of sprays or powders. According to their invention, a method of air conditioning includes the step of exposing the air to a source of germicidal or insecticidal compound which is being subjected to an elevated temperature such that the said compound is converted substantially without decomposition or other form of decomposition to the particulate form the particles having a diameter for the most part of the order of 2µ and not greater than 5µ so that the particles become quantitatively absorbed in the air. The relative humidity of the air should be at least 45—Dichloro-diphenyl-ethane (D. D. T.), or hexyl resorcinol are suitable for use in the above manner.

To carry out the invention, the applicants describe an apparatus comprising a heat conducting body of semi-circular section, an electrical resistance heating element disposed against a flat surface of the body and held in close contact therewith by a flat metal plate forming part of the body, a cylindrical recess disposed substantially centrally in body and extending for nearly the whole depth of the body, a cylindrical container adapted to fit closely in said recess, a thermostat incorporated in said body and spaced from said heater and adapted to determine and control the temperature of the said body by switching the resistance heating element and exchangeable angular members having varying aperture openings adapted to fit over the mouth of said container.
