"A machine for separating stalks from tea leaves",

*Abstract*:—The inventors describe a machine for separating stalks from fired tea comprising at least one pair of soft rubber rollers through which the tea is made to pass. The rollers have the same peripheral velocity. On the discharge side of the rollers the tea and stalk pass over an inclined perforated screen by which the tea is separated. A further pair of rollers may be provided if necessary to separate the balance of the tea left with the stalk. The whole mechanism is mounted on a sub-frame which can be oscillated.

There are 8 claims and 2 sheets of drawings.
