Order

The power to hold a disciplinary inquiry or investigation in respect of the public officers specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto is hereby delegated to the public officer or officers specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that schedule subject to the condition that the powers shall be exercised according to such instructions as may be issued from time to time by the Public Service Commission: Provided, however, that nothing in this order shall authorise or be deemed to authorise the holding of a disciplinary inquiry or investigation in the case of any public officer whose pensionable emoluments exceed £600 or Rs. 9,000 per annum or in the case of any member of the Ceylon Civil Service.
