THE following specifications have been accepted — No 3,528 of February 17, 1948.

Axel Frokjaer-Jensen

"Improvements in and relating to reinforcing steel and a method for the production of the same."

Abstract —Cold treatment of steel, such as twisting increases the strength, but at the expense of elongation. However, by the employment of alloys containing elements which form mixed crystals with iron, e.g., silicon, manganese, &c., it is possible to increase both the elongation as well as resistance to fatigue. According to another feature of the invention, the steel is subjected to stretching followed by twisting or by stretching combined with twisting such that the bar acquires a permanent elongation equal to the elongation of the yield point. The steel may be heat treated to improve its structure.

The carbon content of the steel should be less than 30% and it should have either a sulcon content of '1 to 1 5°0 and a manganese content of 5% to 1 5°0 or a sulcon and manganese content totalling 6 to 2%.

" Method of stabilising rubber latex."

Abstract —The object of the invention is to effect a saving in the amount of stabilising agent used in creaming ribber latex. According to the invention, to the latex is added an amount of stabilising agent insufficient to maintain the latex in stable form throughout the creaming operation and after a lapse of time less than that required to obtain the desired concentration, the separated serium is drawn out, finally more stabilising agent is added and the creaming operation completed. The inventors state the amount of stabilising agent saved is from \(\frac{1}{2} \) of what would ordinarily have been

Abstract —The object of the invention is to form a satisfactory grout when coarse aggregate is placed in situ, and cement mixture is poured over it. It is found that the addition of between 001% and 0.5% (preferably of 0.1%) of a sulphonated or sulphated higher alcohol whose calcium and magnesium salts are readily soluble in water, to the cement mix enables the grout to effectively enter the voids between the aggregate without any settling. No special mixers (such as colloidal mixers) need be used

wherein A represents a benzene nucleus which may optionally bear a halogen, lower alkyl or lower alkoxy substituent or substituents in position meta to the —NH— group, wherein X and Y represent hydrogen or lower alkyl radicals provided that both be not lower alkyl radicals at the same time, wherein R represents a lower alkyl radical, R' represents hydrogen or a lower alkyl radical and wherein R and R' togother contain more than one and fewer than eight carbon atoms, to the action of halogenating agents

"A machine to transplant paddy seedlings under, mid-land 'conditions in muddy fields'

Abstract —The machine comprises a main roller in which are radically fixed stationary distributing pegs. There are also provided radial distributing pegs movable in a radial direction. One stationary peg and one moveable peg form a pair which are connected by "hoad pieces." Crank means actuate the movable peg in such a way that when the head pieces are vertical pointing upwards they pick up the seedlings from the feeding boxes and grip them above the roots and when pointing downwards push the seedlings in the ground and release their hold. The pegs are arranged on the cylindrical roller so that as the drum rotters the seedlings are planted neatly in rows. A "drum roller" is used to support and carry the main roller as otherwise it will sink in the mud, and the whole mechanism is adjustably balanced so that it can be drawn by bullocks.
