"Improvements in or relating to a method of  
applying a rendering of plaster-like material to  
structures"

*Abstract*—The inventors describe a method of  
applying a rendering of a plaster-like material to the  
surface of structures which comprises forming a plaster  
mix adding a wetting, frothing or dispersing agent to  
the mix in an amount of from 0.001 per cent to  
0.5 per cent by weight of the settable solid component  
of said mix, to form a mass of "creamy consistency",  
introducing air into the mass to effect an increase in  
volume of at least 20 per cent and discharging the  
aerated mix on to the surface to be rendered by means  
of an air pressure operated spray gun or like spraying  
device. The amount of air introduced is such as to  
cause an increase of volume from 45 to 55 per cent.  
If cement plaster is used the ratio of sand to cement  
should not exceed 3 to 1 and the ratio of water to  
cement should be between 0.55 to 1 to 0.65 to 1. The  
wetting agent should preferably be a sulphated higher  
alcohol or an alkali metal salt thereof.

"Improvements in or relating to tea rolling  
machines"

*Abstract*—In this machine the tea is rolled between  
the upper surface of a horizontally moving endless belt  
and a stationary surface such that the clearance  
between the two progressively diminishes in the

direction of travel. Adjustments can be made of the  
clearance as well as the speed of the belt to suit parti-  
cular types of leaf that are to be rolled. The top  
portion of the endless belt is carried by rollers so as to  
prevent excessive sag. The belt as well as the  
co-operating surface may be provided with cross  
battens to prevent slip of the leaf. A stationary feed  
hopper is employed for feeding the leaf on to the end-  
less belt, and a combined chute and scraper for  
removing the rolled leaf.

According to a modification a second endless belt  
above the first is arranged in such a way that the leaf  
is rolled between the under surface of the lower run  
of the second belt and the upper surface of the top run  
of the first. The second belt is run either in the same  
or in opposite direction to the first, if the latter its  
speed should be less than that of the first belt.

"Improvements in filter-presses"

*Abstract*—The principle of the device is that the  
mass to be filtered passes through a filtering pipe at  
sufficient velocity to prevent any deposition therein.  
The wall of the tube is the filtering medium and the  
filter can be made to work continuously under pressure  
due to its self cleaning properties. Washing tubes may  
be led into the filtering pipe and fed with any suitable  
fluid. According to another modification the filtering  
tube can be surrounded by an imperforate tube con-  
veying the mass to be filtered at sufficient velocity to  
prevent deposition in the tube and the filtrate can be  
collected from the inside of the tube.
