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

"Reinforced concrete structures and concrete bars therefor

-The inventor describes a thin flexible reinforcing bar made of concrete with a reinforcing tensioned wire or bar situated at the centre of gravity of the bar, the tension of the reinforcement being equalized by the corresponding compressive stresses in the surrounding concrete Such a bar contains no more concrete than that required to carry the compressive stress referred to and normally a section 4 cm by 4 cm will be sufficient. If a stronger bar is required without undue bulk of concrete, initially untensioned steel bars may be incorporated when making the bar so that these are subjected to compressive stresses when the tension on the tensioned bar is relieved Under load the tension on the tensioned bar increases and the compressive stresses on the compressed bars diminish and reverse after a certain load is exceeded By chosing different steels it is possible to arrange for all the bars to attain yield point stress at the same time. In another form of construction a number of tensioned wires may be incorporated in the centre line of a board of concrete Such boards may be used as a shuttering, e g, for a floor, and will remain as part of the reinforcement which the concrete has hardened

"Improvements in processes for dialysing latex and apparatus therefor

Abstract —In dialysing alkaline treated latex by means of horizontal cellophane tubes disposed in flowing water it is found that the tubes deteriorate rapidly. This is due to the fact that cellophane is resistant to hot alkali containing latex only in the absence of oxygen As latex foams somewhat, oxygen tended to remain in the horizontal tubes Furthermore, lumps of coagulated latex forming in the tubes made frequent cleaning necessary

The present invention seeks to remove this defect by providing vertical dialysing tubes the top ends of which are connected by members which are open or can be opened to the atmosphere Any lumps rising in the open connectors can thus be removed. The tubes are arranged in a series of compartments and heated water caused to circulate in counter flow to the direction of the latex
