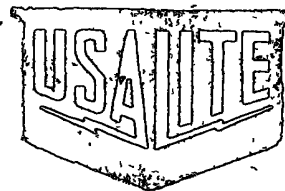

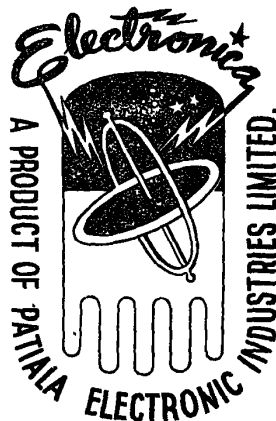

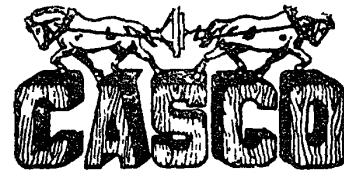

NOTIFICATIONS UNDER "THE PATENTS ORDINANCE, 1906"

"Improved method and apparatus for withering tea leaf"

Abstract — The leaf to be withered is introduced in a stationary drum with horizontal axis. Inside the drum is a shaft provided with rakes or prongs to scoop up and disperse the leaf so as to expose it to the action of the withering medium. Conditioned air is led in and out of the apparatus by suitable openings. Wire mesh may be fitted between the prongs and the drum itself might house appliances generating heat and light to assist the withering process.

There are 6 claims and 1 sheet of drawings.

The following disclaimer has been entered by the applicant at my request —

I am aware of patent No. 2,295 granted to Mr. Thomas Andrew Chalmers. In that invention there is a chamber of brickwork inside which a series of containers is made to rotate. These containers are arranged in such a fashion that the tea leaves to be withered are taken up by each container and dropped to the bottom of the same container, but provision is made so that the leaves pass from one container to the other and finally out of the machine in a withered state. Thus in this machine the withering is a continuous process.

In my invention there is an outside casing inside which is made to rotate a shaft which carries scoops or other similar devices. These scoops pick up the leaf to be withered from the bottom of the chamber and having in the course of their revolution taken the leaf to the top drop it again to the bottom of the chamber. This process is not continuous as each charge of leaf to be withered has to be introduced to the casing or drum and after being treated has got to be discharged before another charge of leaf is put into the drum. I do not claim the method or apparatus disclosed in patent No. 2,295.
