" A process for the preparation of Halogenated, more particularly chlorinated, rubber derivatives "

Abstract —The inventors describe a process for the preparation of halogenated and more particularly

chlorinated rubber derivatives characterized in that a dispersion of a rubber derivative, e.g., rubber-hydrochloride, halogenrubber is halogenated. The gaseous chlorine is passed into the dispersion at increased temperature and if desired at higher pressure than normal. The dispersion may be irradiated with light rays and/or ultra-violet rays. Preferably the starting dispersion should have free acid present
