"A new type of steel nm for cant wheels for securely fixing solid rubber tyres"

Abstract.—The inventor describes an iron rim with cover plate welded to it on one side which is shrunk on to the wheel. The rubber tyre is vulcanized on to a thin metal band provided with clips to hold the tyre in place. The band is slipped on to the iron rim and the cover plate on the outerside secured with set screws. A series of study on the inside of the cover plate are provided to prevent rotation of the tyre relative to the iron. For additional security the shrunk rim is fixed to the telloes by wood series.
