PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies

HENRY MOORE.

KNOW Ye that by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 15 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, I, Henry Monck-Mason Moore, Governor-General, do by this Proclamation prorogue Parliament with effect from midnight of June 17, 1949, fix July 12, 1949, as the date for the next session, and summon Parliament to meet at the Parliament Hall, House of Representatives, Colombo, on Tuesday, July 12, 1949, at 10 a m

Given at Colombo, this Seventeenth day of June, One thousand Nine hundred and Forty-nine.
