Greeting :

WHEREAS it appears to me to be necessary to appoint a Commission for the purposes hereinafter mentioned :

Now, therefore, I, Herwald, Baron Soulbury, Governor-General, reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence, ability and fidelity, do in pursuance

of the provisions of section 2 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, No. 17 of 1948, by these presents appoint you, the said Chellappah Nagalingam, Edward Frederick Noel Gratiaen, Frederick Austin Hayley, Norman Edward Weerasooria and Geoffrey Thomas Hale, to be my Commissioners for the purpose of—

- (1) inquiring into the procedure, practice and administration of the civil courts of Ceylon and reporting on such reforms as may be necessary in matters of law or practice or in the administration of those courts in order to secure greater efficiency and expedition in the transaction of business in those courts with due regard to public interest;
- (2) examining the Civil Procedure Code (Chapter 86) and reporting—
 - (a) whether it is adequate to meet modern requirements from the point of view of ensuring efficient and expeditious transaction of business in the aforesaid courts, and
 - (b) if not, whether it should be replaced by a new Civil Procedure Code or whether the necessary reforms can be effected by amendments or additions to it; and
- (3) preparing and submitting a draft of a new Civil Procedure Code or alternatively a draft of such amendments and additions to the existing Civil Procedure Code as may be considered necessary:

And I do hereby appoint you, the said Chellappah Nagalingam, to be the Chairman of the said Commission:

And I do hereby authorise and empower you, the said Commissioners, to hold all such inquiries and make all such investigations into the aforesaid matters as may appear to you to be necessary, and require you to transmit to me, as early as possible, a report thereon under your hand together with a draft of such legislation relating to the procedure of the civil courts of Ceylon as you may consider necessary:

And I do hereby direct that such part of any inquiry relating to the aforesaid matters as you may in your discretion determine shall not be held in public:

And I do hereby require and direct all public officers and other persons, to whom you may apply for assistance or information for the purposes of your inquiries and investigations, to render all such assistance and furnish all such information as may properly be rendered and furnished in that behalf.

WHEREAS it appears to me to be necessary to appoint a Commission for the purposes hereinafter mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, Herwald, Baron Soulbury, Governor-General, reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence, ability and fidelity, do in pursuance

of the provisions of section 2 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, No. 17 of 1948, by these presents appoint you the said George Crossette Thambyah to be my Commissioner for the purpose of—

- (1) reviewing the law in Ceylon relating to the functions of Fiscals and the procedure for the transaction of business in the Fiscals' departments, and recommending such amendments to that law and procedure as may be necessary for removing any defects that may be found therein;
- (2) inquiring into and reporting on the organisation and operative methods of the Fiscals' departments, making recommendations as to the changes that should be effected in such organisation and methods, and formulating a system for co-ordinating the work of the various Fiscals; and
- (3) preparing and submitting a manual of procedure for the transaction of business in Fiscals' departments:

 - (ii) if such person is a member of the Engineering or Mechanical Staff, appeal to the Chief Mechanical Engineer (Head Quarters);
- (d) in the case of a decision made by any Deputy Chief Engineer, Way and Works, Assistant Chief Engineer, Way and Works, District Engineer, Way and Works, or Signal Engineer, Way and Works, appeal to the Chief Engineer, Way and Works;
- (e) in the case of a decision made by any Assistant to the General Manager (Administrative) appeal to the Chief Administrative Officer;
- (f) in the case of a decision made by any Assistant to the General Manager (Operating)—
- (i) if the person is a member of the Traffic Staff, appeal to the Operating Superintendent; and
 - (ii) if the person is a member of the Engineering or Mechanical Staff, appeal to the Chief Mechanical Engineer (Head Quarters);
- (g) in the case of a decision made by any Inspector (Permanent Way and Bridges) or Foreman (Permanent Way, Buildings and Bridges), appeal to the District Engineer, Way and Works;
- (h) in the case of a decision made by any Inspector (Signals) or Foreman (Signals), appeal to the Signal Engineer, Way and Works;
- (i) in the case of a decision made by any Deputy Mechanical Engineer, appeal to the Chief Mechanical Engineer (Ratmalana);
- (j) in the case of a decision made by any Foreman (Ratmalana Workshops) or Boiler Inspector, appeal to the Deputy Mechanical Engineer;
- (k) in the case of a decision made by any Assistant Divisional Transportation Superintendent, Inspector (Traffic and Mechanical), Depot Master (Colombo Yard), Station Superintendent (Port), Goods Agent, Station Master (Special Class or Class I) or Foreman (Running Sheds), appeal to the Divisional Transportation Superintendent;
- (l) in the case of a decision made by any Foreman (Running Sheds) at Dematagoda, appeal to the Assistant Divisional Transportation Superintendent, Dematagoda; and
- (m) in the case of a decision made by any Foreman (Running Sheds) at Maligawatte, appeal to the Assistant Divisional Transportation Superintendent (Carriage and Wagons), Maligawatte:
- Provided that any person dissatisfied with the decision made by an officer to whom he has appealed under the provisions of any one of the following clauses, that is to say, clauses (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l) and (m) of sub-paragraph (ii) may appeal from such decision to the General Manager.”;

(2) by the re-numbering of paragraph 2 as paragraph 3; and

(3) by the insertion, immediately after paragraph 1, of the following new paragraph—

“ 2. The powers delegated to any officer under paragraph 1 of this Order shall be subject to the following conditions—

- (a) that those powers shall be exercised according to such instructions as may be issued from time to time by the Public Service Commission; and
- (b) that in any case where the Public Service Commission decides that any power of punishment delegated to such officer shall be exercised by the Public Service Commission, such officer shall not exercise that power in that case.”
