The Distinguished Conduct Medal

GEORGE R.

GEORGE THE SIXTH, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith, to all to whom these Presents shall come:

Greeting!

WHEREAS Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, by a Warrant under Her Royal Sign Manual dated the 30th day of September, 1862, did institute and create a silver medal bearing the words "For Distinguished Conduct in the Field";

AND WHEREAS the rules and ordinances for the governance of the same have been amended from time to time and were consolidated and varied by a Warrant under the Sign Manual of His late Majesty King George V dated the 5th day of February, 1931;

AND WHEREAS His late Majesty King George V in the said Warrant dated the 5th day of February, 1931, reserved to Himself, His Heirs and Successors full power of annulling, altering, abrogating, augmenting or dispensing with these rules and ordinances, or any part thereof, by a notification under Royal Sign Manual;

AND WHEREAS the said Royal Warrant was amended by Warrants under Our Sign Manual dated the 21st day of August, 1939, and the 16th day of July, 1947;

AND WHEREAS We deem it expedient that the said Royal Warrant dated the 5th day of February, 1931, should be further amended;

Now THEREFORE WE do hereby declare that the rules and ordinances contained in the said Royal Warrant dated 5th day of February, 1931, as amended by Our said Warrants dated the 21st day of August, 1939, and the 16th day of July, 1947, shall be abrogated, cancelled and annulled, and We are pleased to make, ordain and establish the following rules and ordinances in substitution for the same which shall from henceforth be inviolably observed and kept:—

Firstly: It is ordained that the Medal, which shall be of silver, shall be designated "The Distinguished Conduct Medal", shall bear on the obverse the Royal Effigy, and on the reverse the words "For Distinguished Conduct in the Field".

Secondly It is ordained that the Distinguished Conduct Medal may be awarded in any of Our Naval, Military or Air Forces, including the Forces of Our Dominions beyond the seas, the Forces of Our Colonies, Protectorates, or Territories Mandated to the United Kingdom, and the Sudan Defence Force, on the recommendation of a Commander-in-Chief in the Field or, in the case of any of Our Dominions the Government whereof shall so desire, of the Officer Commanding the Dominion Forces in the Field, to Warrant Officers, non-commissioned officers and men and equivalent ranks, for distinguished conduct in action in the Field, provided that awards in Our Naval or Air Forces shall be made only for services similar to those undertaken by Our Military Forces

Thirdly: It is ordained that should anyone who has been awarded the Distinguished Conduct Medal be subsequently recommended for such approved act or acts of distinguished conduct in action in the Field as would have rendered him eligible for the Medal, had he not already received it, he may be awarded a Bar to be attached to the ribbon by which the Medal is suspended, and that for every additional such act or acts of distinguished conduct an additional Bar may be awarded; and that when the ribbon alone is worn, the award of a Bar shall be indicated by a silver rose Emblem attached to the ribbon, the award of an additional Bar being indicated by a further such Emblem.

Fourthly It is ordained that the Distinguished Conduct Medal shall not confer any individual precedence, but shall entitle the recipient to the addition after his name of the letters, D.C.M.

Fifthly: It is ordained that the names of those upon whom We may be pleased to confer the Distinguished Conduct Medal shall be published in the *London Gazette* and that a Register thereof shall be kept in the Office of Our Principal Secretary of State for War

Sixthly: It is ordained that the Distinguished Conduct Medal shall be worn before war medals in such order as We may from time to time assign to it, and that it shall be worn on the left breast pendent from a ribbon of one inch and one quarter in width, which shall be in colour crimson, having in the centre a dark blue stripe of width equal to the crimson stripes on each side of it.

Seventhly It is ordained that Warrant Officers, non-commissioned officers or men belonging to any of Our Military Forces or any of equivalent rank belonging to Our Naval or Air Forces of the United Kingdom, of Our Dominions beyond the seas, or of Our Colonies, Protectorates or Territories Mandated to the United Kingdom, or of the Sudan Defence Force, who have been awarded the Distinguished Conduct Medal, or a Bar or Bars thereto, shall receive such monetary award as the Government concerned may prescribe.

Eighthly. It is ordained that members of an Allied or Associated Navy, Army, or Air Force, of ranks equivalent to those of Our Military Forces specified in the second Clause of this Our Warrant, who have been associated in operations with Our Naval, Military or Air Forces, shall be eligible for the award of the Distinguished Conduct Medal but no pension or gratuity shall accompany such award

Ninthly. It is ordained that it shall be competent for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, by an Order under Our Sign Manual and on the recommendation to that effect by or through Our Principal Secretary of State for War, or in the case of any of Our Dominions, the Government whereof shall so desire, by the appropriate Minister of

State for the said Dominion, to cancel and annul the award of the Distinguished Conduct Medal to any person, together with any gratuity, or pension in lieu thereof, appertaining thereto not already paid, and that thereupon his name in the Register shall be erased; but it shall be competent for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, to restore the Medal when such recommendation has been withdrawn and with it such gratuity, or pension in lieu thereof, as may have been forfeited.

Tenthly: It is ordained that notice of cancellation or restoration in every case shall be published in the *London Gazette*.

Lastly: We reserve to Ourselves, Our Heirs and Successors, full power of annulling, altering, abrogating, augmenting, interpreting or dispensing with these regulations, or any part thereof, by a notification under Our Sign Manual.
