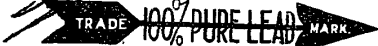

"An improved process and apparatus for the drying of tea leaf in vacuum"

Abstract—The inventor claims a process and apparatus for drying tea in which the mass is subjected simultaneously to vacuum and heat. The apparatus comprises a rotatable drum which can be charged with leaf and connected to a vacuum pipe. The leaf is heated by fluids heating the drum on the outside. The drums claimed in Ceylon Patents Nos 3356 and 3594 may be used for this purpose
