" Improvements in process and in producing a variety of white fibre from the husk of coconuts"

Abstract — The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which is as follows: — An improved process for producing a variety of white fibre from the husk of coconuts by the extraction of the pulpy tannic embedding substances by chemical action so that all fibre stands loose, characterised by first preparing a non-volatile alkali of moderate power by mixing two parts of dehydrated carbonate of soda and one part of sodium chloride by weight, boiling them in milk of lime until the alkali is free of carbonic gas, then adding this chemical preparation to cold water till the mixture reaches a specific gravity of between 1 5 to 1 20 according to the type of husk to be retted
