RESOLUTION

This House resolves under section 9 of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 185), as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, that—

- (1) with effect from the date on which this resolution is notified in the *Gazette*, the export duty on the goods specified in column I of the Schedule to this resolution shall be levied and paid at the rates prescribed in column II of that Schedule; and
- (2) nothing contained in this resolution shall affect any export duties leviable and payable on the aforesaid goods under any written law other than the Customs Ordinance.
