IT is hereby notified that the following resolution under section 9 of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 185), as modified by the Proclamation published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, was passed by the House of Representatives at its public session on February 16, 1950.

RESOLUTION

This House resolves under section 9 of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 185), as modified by the Proclamation published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, that-

- (1) with effect from the date on which this resolution is notified in the Gazette, the export duty on the goods specified in column I of the Schedule to this resolution shall be levied and paid at the rates prescribed in column II of that Schedule; and
- (2) nothing contained in this resolution shall affect any export duties leviable and payable on the aforesaid goods under any written law other than the Customs Ordinance.
