Miscellaneous Departmental Notices**UNEMPLOYMENT CENSUS, 1949****Explanatory Note**

THE tables given below show the number of persons who were reported as unemployed on October 24, 1949. The statistics were obtained at the Unemployment Census taken between October 24, 1949, and November 6, 1949. They are based on a preliminary handcount of the unemployment schedules, and are provisional being subject to final revision.

2. *Table I* shows the distribution of all unemployed persons, classified by sex, according to Revenue Districts.

Table II shows the distribution of unemployed persons in urban areas only, classified by sex, according to Municipal Councils and Urban Councils.

Table III shows the distribution of unemployed persons in rural areas only (exclusive of Municipal Councils, Urban Councils and "A" estates) classified by sex, according to D. R. OO Divisions.

Table IV shows the distribution of unemployed persons, classified by sex, resident on "A" estates*, according to Revenue Districts.

Table V shows the distribution of unemployed persons, classified by sex, in the Colombo Municipality according to wards.

Table VI shows the distribution of unemployed persons previously engaged in "casual" occupations according to Revenue Districts.

Table VII shows the distribution of unemployed persons previously engaged in "casual" occupations, according to Municipal Councils and Urban Councils.

3. For the purpose of the census only unemployed persons between the ages of 17 and 60 (both years inclusive) who were without any employment whatsoever on October 24, 1949, and who desired regular employment throughout the year were included. As such, the figures do not include (1) persons who are not really unemployed, but are under-employed and (2) persons who have only seasonal employment.

Unemployed persons, so defined, are grouped into two categories, viz.: (1) previously employed but now unemployed, and (2) not previously employed but desiring employment. The tables show these two groups separately and compare them with the number of persons who were reported as unemployed in the Population Census of 1946.

For purposes of comparison it should be noted that only the figures of persons previously employed are comparable with the number of persons reported as unemployed in the 1946 Census, which defined an unemployed person as one having had a previous employment.

4. A number of persons were enumerated as having previously had "Casual" employments. The figures in Table I-IV are inclusive of these persons. Tables VI and VII show the distribution of this "casual" labour who were without employment on the date of the Census.

5. Persons employed on unemployment relief schemes throughout the Island on October 24, 1949, were excluded from the Census. These amounted to 5,780 in all.

* An "A" estate is one which is 20 acres or more in extent, has ten or more resident labourers and is in charge of a Superintendent who was capable of filling up the schedules in English.
