The Courts Ordinance

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 26 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6), as modified by the Proclamation under Section 88 (1) of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order-in-Council, 1946, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Edwin Arthur Lewis Wijeyewardene, Chief Justice, do, after consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, hereby alter the date of the commencement of the First Sessions of the Supreme Court for the Midland Circuit required by that Section to be holden at Kandy on the tenth day of March, 1950, and fix the seventeenth day of April, 1950, as the date of the commencement of the said Sessions of the Supreme Court.
