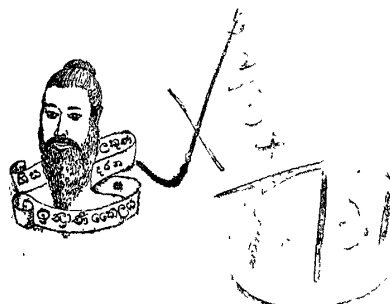

"Method and apparatus for splicing inner tubes".

*Abstract*:—The invention relates to a method of and apparatus for splicing inner tubes of vulcanizable material and is more particularly useful for splicing tubes made of material such as butyl rubber which is less tacky and more fluent under pressure than natural rubber.

The tube to be spliced has its ends cut in planes at right angles to its length to provide square, clean ends for adhesive contact. After cutting, the ends are placed in contact and the tube ends are pressed between a bed and a platen so as to completely flatten the ends of the tube and bring the abutting edges into full contact throughout the width of the flattened tube. The tube ends are engaged by a gripping arrangement which consists of two pairs of gripping bars to which gripping pressure is applied for a time interval sufficient to permit the knurling to sink somewhat into the faces of the tube, thereby improving the grip, after which the two pairs of gripping bars are moved one towards the other while the gripping pressure is maintained to apply end-wise pressure to the abutting tube ends. In order to prevent lateral flow of rubber from the splice at the opposite side edges of the tube, blocks of sponge rubber are inserted between the tube gripper bars and against opposite side edges of the tube. Pressure is maintained on the tube ends for a substantial time interval sufficient to cause the tube ends to firmly adhere so that subsequent vulcanization will cause complete joining of the rubber at the splice.

The above operations are preferably performed in a tube splicing machine such as is illustrated and described in the specification.

"Tube Splicer".

*Abstract*:—This invention relates to a method of and apparatus for splicing inner tubes of vulcanizable material prior to vulcanization and relates to improvements in splicing machines as described in specification No. 3,647, a particular feature of the present invention being the provision on the confronting edges of the thin flanges of the lower gripper bars of closely spaced notches which form serrated edges on the flanges. In pressing the abutting ends together one side of the abutted ends is compressed more than the other to produce a relatively thicker wall portion along the splice on one side of the flattened tube than on the other.
