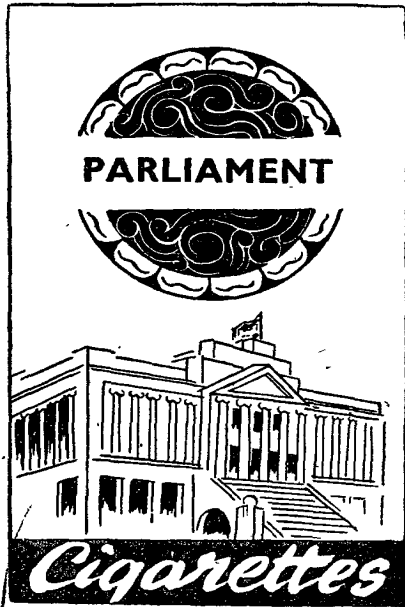

"The electrical control and animated reproduction of race games."

Abstract.—The Invention describes a device for translating on to an illuminated racing track the motions in race games so as to trace an animated moving picture of the race whilst in progress. The participants in the "race" are seated on dummy horses and by making electrical contacts through whip, spurs, reins, &c., operate relays which move the silhouettes of the horses over the illuminated track. A clear indication is given of the order in which the competitors are placed.

There are 8 claims and 3 sheets of drawings.
