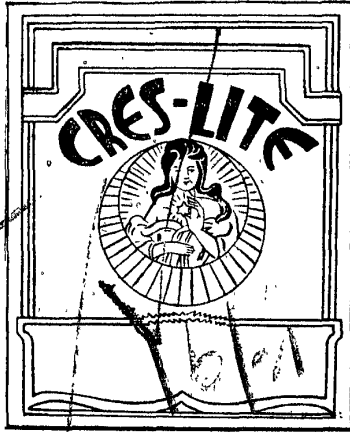

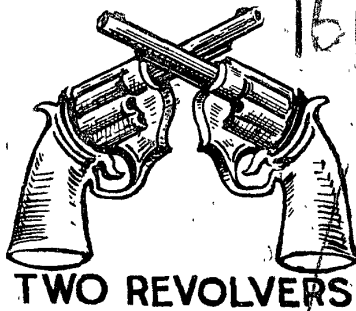

THE following specification has been accepted:—

No. 3,637 of May 24, 1949

Shirley John Bocks.

"A calculating frame"

Abstract:—The calculating frame which comprises this invention is adopted for additions and subtractions and multiplication and division of quantities in pounds,

shillings and pence and in rupees, annas and pice or in decimal currencies. It is made of wood and has twelve central spindles located in four groups each with three spindles. These spindles carry beads, the numbers on each being different for the different currencies.

Provision is made for inserting pegs in order to divide the frame into separate zones for ease in computation.

There are three claims and one sheet of drawings.
