(the 5th to 7th minor respondents are represented by their guardian *ad litem* the 1st respondent, Mawanna Muttiah aforesaid), (8) Sewadamma (widow of Kathirevelu, but now wife of 4th respondent, Mawanna Suppamaniam), (9) Sana Maruthadore, a minor, aged about 17 years, (10) Sana Sanmugam, a minor, aged about 14 years (the 9th and 10th minor respondents are represented by their guardian *ad litem*, their mother the 2nd respondent, Mawanna Kalai), all of Kandiah Estate, Horaguna, Haldummulla Respondents.

THIS matter coming on for disposal before A. L. S. Srimanne, Esq., District Judge of Badulla, on June 27, 1950, in the presence of Mr. K. V. Nadarajah, Proctor, on the part of the petitioners; and their affidavit dated June 23, 1950, and the affidavit of the witnesses

to the last will of the deceased testate dated June 26, 1950, having been read

It is ordered—

- (a) that the 1st respondent above named be and he is hereby appointed guardian *ad litem* over the 5th, 6th, and 7th minor respondents, and the 2nd respondent above named be and she is hereby appointed guardian *ad litem* over the 9th and 10th minor respondents for all the purposes of representing them in the above proceedings, unless the 1st and 2nd respondents aforesaid or any person or persons lawfully interested therein shall, on or before August 31, 1950, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary, and
- (b) that the last will and testament made by the deceased above named bearing No. 1,313 dated September 15, 1945, attested by G. W. R. Jayawardena, Notary Public, the original of which has been produced with its translation and now deposited in this court, be and the same is hereby proved, and the petitioners above named are the executors named therein, and they are hereby declared entitled to have probate thereof issued to them accordingly, unless the respondents above named or any person or persons lawfully interested therein shall, on or before June 31, 1950, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.

It is further ordered that the 1st and 2nd respondents should produce in court the aforesaid minors on the said date.
