ORDER UNDER PROVISO TO SECTION 36

Order No. 7 of 1950

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 36 of the Land Acquisition Act, No. 9 of 1950, T, Dudley Shelton Senanayako, Minister of Agriculture and Lands, do hereby direct the Government Agent, Assistant Government Agent or other officer authorised in that behalf by such Government Agent or Assistant Government Agent and referred to in Column I of the Schedule hereto, to take possession of the land specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that Schedule.
