ORDER (No. 36)

The powers specified in column I of the Schedule hereto are hereby delegated to the officer specified in the corresponding entry in column II of that Schedule, subject to the following conditions:—

- that those powers shall be exercised according to such instructions as may be issued from time to time by the Public Service Commission;
- that any person dissatisfied with the decision made by such officer under any power delegated to such officer under this Order may appeal therefrom to the Public Service Commission; and
- that, in any case where the Public Service Commission decides that any power of punishment delegated to such officer shall be exercised by the Public Service Commission, such officer shall not exercise that power in that case.

REGULATIONS

The regulations published in *Gazette* No. 10,096 of April 21, 1950, are hereby amended as follows:—

- (1) in regulation 3 thereof, by the substitution, for the words "in the form", of the words "in the Form A";
- (2) by the substitution, for regulation 11 thereof, of the following new regulation:—

" 11. (1) No loan shall be granted upon the mortgage of any land unless the buildings and machinery standing thereon have been insured against fire with an Insurance Company affiliated to the Fire Insurance Association of Ceylon for such amount as shall be determined by the Board.

(2) Where the loan is utilised for the purposes of the erection of any building or buildings upon the land mortgaged as security, every such building shall be insured with an Insurance Company referred to in paragraph (1) for such amount as shall be determined by the Board; and the fourth instalment referred to in regulation 12 shall not be paid until the provisions of this paragraph are complied with.

(3) Every policy of insurance under the preceding provisions of this regulation shall be renewed annually before the date on which the premium on it becomes due and the receipt of the insurance company acknowledging payment of the premium shall be forwarded annually to the Secretary of the Board."

- (3) by the re-numbering of regulation 22 thereof, as regulation 24;
- (4) by the insertion, immediately after regulation 21 thereof, of the following new regulations:—

" 22. Every mortgage of land executed in favour of the Board shall be substantially in such one of the Forms B and C set out in the Schedule hereto as may be appropriate to the case.

23. Every certificate of sale referred to in section 34 of the Act shall be substantially in the Form D set out in the Schedule hereto", and

(5) in the Schedule to the regulations—

- (a) by the insertion, immediately before the heading "HOUSING LOANS BOARD", of the new heading "Form A"; and
- (b) by the insertion, immediately after the Form relating to an "Application for a loan under the Housing Loans Act, No. 26 of 1949", of the following new Forms:—

FORM B

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME A _____ B _____ of _____ (hereinafter called "the Obligor" which expression shall where the context so requires or admits mean and include the said A _____ B _____ his heirs executors and administrators)

SENDS GREETING:—

WHEREAS the Obligor is seised and possessed of and lawfully entitled to the property and premises in the first schedule hereto fully described (hereinafter called "the said premises") free from all encumbrances.

AND WHEREAS the Obligor has applied to the HOUSING LOANS BOARD (a body corporate with perpetual succession and a Common Seal established by the Housing Loans Act, No. 26 of 1949, and hereinafter called "the Board") for the grant of a loan of Rupees _____ (Rs. _____) under the said Housing Loans Act, No. 26 of 1949, on the primary mortgage of the said premises for the purpose of promoting and executing a housing scheme in accordance with plans and specifications duly signed by the Obligor and approved by and deposited with the Board (hereinafter referred to as "the said plans and specifications") on the property and premises called and known as _____ and bearing assessments Nos. _____ in the second schedule hereto fully described.

AND WHEREAS the Board has agreed to grant such loan to the Obligor for the purpose aforesaid on having the repayment thereof with interest secured in the manner and on the conditions hereinafter provided.

NOW THIS BOND WITNESSETH as follows:—

IN pursuance of the said agreement and in consideration of the sum of Rupees _____ (Rs. _____) paid to the Obligor by the Board in four instalments as hereinafter provided the Obligor hereby covenants with the Board, subject to the provisions of Clause 4 (c) (v), to repay to the Board the said sum of Rupees _____ (Rs. _____) by equal half yearly instalments of Rupees _____ (Rs. _____) on the _____ day of _____ and the _____ day of _____ in each and every year such instalments in repayment to commence on the expiration of a period of one year from the date appointed for the completion of the said scheme, which date shall be reckoned to be the _____ day of _____ that is to say the first of such instalments in repayment shall commence on the _____ day of _____. The Obligor further covenants with the Board that he will on the date of payment of each of the said instalments to the Board also pay interest on the total sum then advanced to him or on so much thereof as shall for the time being remain due and owing at the rate of _____ per centum per annum and in the event of default being made then at the rate of _____ per centum per annum.

2. The principal sum of the loan hereby granted shall be payable by the Board in manner following:—

- (a) a sum of rupees _____ (Rs. _____) upon the execution and registration of these presents;
- (b) a sum of Rupees _____ (Rs. _____) upon the production of a report from an Engineer nominated by or at the instance of the Board to the effect that the foundation of each house or unit of residential accommodation constituting the said housing scheme has reached ground level or that at least one-third of such houses or units has been completed;
- (c) a sum of Rupees _____ (Rs. _____) upon production of a similar report to the effect that the walls including the window and door frames of the houses or units of residential

accommodation constituting the said housing scheme have reached roof level or that at least one half of such houses or units has been completed;

- (d) a sum of Rupees _____ (Rs. _____) being the final instalment upon the production of a final report from the Engineer to the effect that such houses or units of residential accommodation constituting the whole housing scheme have been completed in every respect according to the said plans and specifications which said completion shall be effected on or before the said _____ days of _____ 19____. Provided however that nothing herein contained shall affect the right of the Board at any time after the grant of a loan has been approved and before the payment of any instalment as aforesaid in its discretion and without assigning any reason therefor to cancel the grant of the loan or to modify the conditions on which the loan is made or to withhold payment of the whole or any portion of the money. Provided, further, that any decision of the Board in modification of the said conditions or withholding payment of any portion of the money as aforesaid shall in no wise affect the mortgage and hypothecation created by these presents as respects any sum already advanced or which may be advanced under these presents

3. And for further securing to the Board the payment of all moneys payable under and by virtue of in respect of these presents, the Obligor doth hereby specially mortgage to the Board as a first or primary mortgage free of all encumbrances the said premises and all the rights privileges easements servitudes and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining or used or enjoyed therewith or reputed or known as part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever of the Obligor in to upon or out of the said premises.

4 The Obligor further covenants with the Board —

- (a) that the said premises in the first schedule hereto fully described are in no wise howsoever encumbered and that he the obligor now has full power and legal right to mortgage and hypothecate the same and that he shall and will at the request of the Board but at the cost and expense of himself the obligor do and execute or cause to be done and executed all such further and other acts deeds assurances and things for the more perfectly and effectually assuring to the Board by way of mortgage and hypothecation the said premises or any part or portion thereof as by the Board shall or may be reasonably required.

- (1) in the event of the Obligor failing or neglecting to pay any rates and charges or other assessments payable as hereinbefore provided the Board shall be entitled to pay the same on account of the Obligor but no liability to do so is created hereunder.
- (2) in the event of the Obligor failing or neglecting to insure and keep insured against fire at all times during the continuance of this security all the buildings standing on the said premises mortgaged hereby in their full value or to renew the premiums payable on such policy of insurance then the Board shall be entitled to effect such policy and pay such premia on account of the Obligor but no liability to do so is created hereunder.
- (3) in the event of the Obligor failing or neglecting to keep in a state of good and substantial repair and in tenantable condition all buildings standing on the said premises then the Board shall be entitled to carry out such repairs and effect such improvements as may be deemed necessary to prevent deterioration of the same and to maintain them in tenantable condition on account of the Obligor but no liability to do so is created hereunder.

ALL such moneys expended by the Board in payment of any rates taxes assessments or other charges in effecting the insurance of all or any such buildings against fire or in the payment of any premia or renewals of the same or in repairing the buildings standing on the said premises hereby mortgaged or in effecting such improvements as may become necessary for their maintenance in a tenable condition or for the prevention of any deterioration of the same shall be payable to the Board by the Obligor on demand with interest at the rate _____ per centum per annum and shall be a charge on the said premises and form part of the amount due hereunder and recoverable in the manner provided for the recovery of the said principal and interest.

PROVIDED further that in the event of any default being made by the Obligor in the payment of any one or more of the said instalments of principal or interest or if the Obligor shall become bankrupt or enter into any statutory or other composition or arrangement with his creditors generally, or in the event of any default in the observance or performance of any of the covenants hereinbefore expressed or implied, then and in any such case the whole of the moneys then payable under this deed shall be deemed to be forthwith due and owing and payable to the Board and the Board may call upon the Obligor to repay on or before a prescribed date all sums of money then payable whether as principal or interest or such sums as may have been expended by the Board in payment of any rates charges and assessments as hereinbefore referred to or in effecting such insurance as is hereinbefore provided or in the maintenance of the buildings on the said premises in manner aforesaid and in default of such payment within such prescribed time the Board may—

- (1) exercise all the statutory powers conferred on the Board by the Housing Loans Act, No 26 of 1949, or any Act amending the same;
- (2) take possession of and manage and maintain the said premises hereby mortgaged under the provisions of section 23 of the said Housing Loans Act and
 - (a) demise or let the said premises hereby mortgaged for such period and at such rents and upon such terms as the Board shall think fit; and
