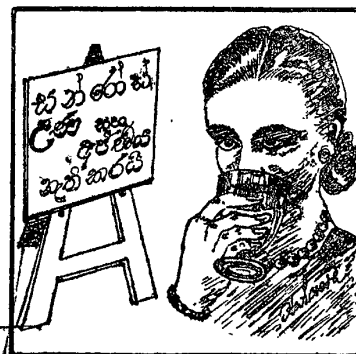

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Notifications under "The Patents Ordinance, 1906"

"A machine for the production of containers filled with liquids or pastes"

Abstract.—This invention relates to a machine for the production of containers filled with liquids or pastes. A length of tubing of a pliable non metallic material of thermoplastic nature like vinyl resin, (or in particular polyvinyl chloride) adapted to provide a number of con-

tainers is filled and pressure is applied laterally to the tubing walls at distances apart equal to the length of a single container to cause the contents to be displaced from the places where the pressure is applied so that the walls of the tubing make contact with each other thereat. The contacting walls are welded together by heat produced electrically which is applied after application of pressure. This produces a tube like container welded at both ends. The containers are separated by cutting along the centre of the width of the welded place whereby the ends are also sealed.
