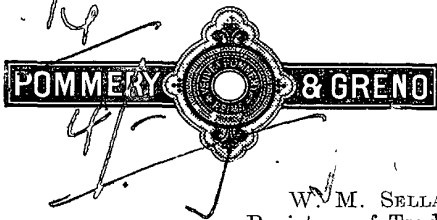

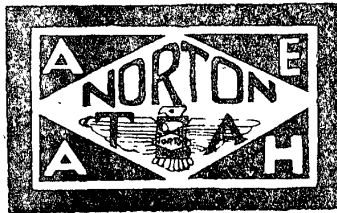

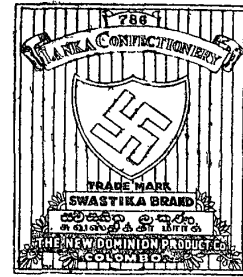

"Process for the production of combustible gases"

Abstract.—This invention relates to the production of combustible gases from carbonaceous solid fuels with oxygen or oxygen enriched air and more particularly with the production of mixtures of CO and H₂ as are produced by the operation of water gas generators. In this invention the solid fuel is in finely divided form and suspended in a gaseous medium unlike in the usual generators.

The finely divided solid fuel in homogeneous suspension in a quantity of O₂ or O₂ enriched air insufficient to effect complete conversion of its C content into CO is injected into a combustion zone maintained at a sufficiently high temperature to effect ignition and is surrounded by a continuous envelope of preheated steam or carbon dioxide or mixtures of these. This envelope moving forward into the gasification chamber concurrently with the injected suspension insulates the refractory walls from the extremely high temperatures produced by the combustion. This insulation is also more effective in view of the endothermic reaction of the heated carbon and the steam or carbon dioxide. The endothermic reaction also prevents the melting of the ash particles and the consequent fusing. The ash is thereby obtained in a non glassy state.

"Process for the production of combustible gases."

Abstract.—This invention relates to the production of combustible gases from finely pulverized solid fuels. The process consists of suspending in oxygen pulverized solid fuels whose gram size is 0.086 mm or below. This suspension is continuously delivered in the form of a jet that has a velocity sufficient to maintain the pulverized fuel in suspension into a gasification chamber that is preheated to a temperature above the ignition temperature of the said suspension. This jet is continuously surrounded by an envelope of fluid oxide that can react endothermically with hot carbon to give combustible gas so that diffusion of reactants and gases of said jet into the said envelope gasifies carbon that escapes gasification in the jet itself. The suspension of solid fuel particles has to be introduced into the gasification chamber as a jet having a velocity of not less than 0.1 meter per second.

"Gasification apparatus."

Abstract.—This invention relates in general to the continuous production of combustible gases from a carbonaceous solid fuel by its reactions with oxygen or oxygen enriched air. The fuel in finely pulverized form is held in suspension in the oxygen or oxygen enriched air. This suspension is continuously introduced in the form of a jet into a gasification chamber preheated to a temperature above the ignition temperature of the suspension. The suspension is quickly ignited while surrounded by a concurrently flowing envelope containing steam or other fluid oxide that can react endothermally with hot carbon thereby causing two distinct zones to exist simultaneously—one a central highly heated zone and the other outer zone of a lower temperature. The present invention seeks to provide an improved apparatus to assure that the above mentioned zones are maintained to a large degree functionally separate. The special means for introducing the steam or other fluid oxide is described with reference to the sheet of drawings which forms part of the specification.
