

Notifications under "The Patents Ordinance, 1906"

THE following specification has been accepted. —

Triplejay Equipment (Proprietary) Limited.

"An improved Brick or Block Moulding Machine".

Abstract.—This invention relates to an improved moulding machine or apparatus for producing bricks, blocks and the like. This portable moulding machine has at least one mould space closable as regards one end by a lid or like closure. The composition is moulded or compressed by a movable press plate co-acting with the opposite end. At least one pair of toggle lever arms, pivotally connected together at their inner ends by a common knuckle joint or the like, their opposing outer ends being connected one to a frame or other immovable object and the other to a movable plunger coacting with an extension of said press plate. The toggle lever arms are operated by hand lever linked to the knuckle joint so that when the hand lever is initially operated toggle lever action takes place forcing the plunger member against the movable press plate. Further movement of the lever arm after opening of the closure forces the toggle lever arms beyond this dead centre position thereby withdrawing the plunger member and simultaneously causes the moulded article to be ejected from the mould space. The machine frame is mounted on two or more wheels.
