ORDER

1. The term of office of the members of the Chilaw Urban Council and the Puttalam Urban Council, which is due to expire on December 31, 1950, is hereby extended to, and shall expire on, January 31, 1951.

2. The term of office of the members elected at the general elections of members of the Chilaw Urban Council and the Puttalam Urban Council due to be held for the purpose of electing new members in place of the members whose term of office has been extended to, and is due to expire on, January 31, 1951, shall commence on February 1, 1951.

ORDER

Notwithstanding anything in the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance, No. 53 of 1946—

- (a) the notice heretofore published under section 39 of the Ordinance for the purposes of the general elections of members of the Chilaw Urban Council and the Puttalam Urban Council which were due to be held in the month of December, 1950, for the purpose of the election of new members in place of the members whose term of office was due to expire on December 31, 1950, shall be, and shall at all times be deemed to have been, void and of no effect whatsoever; and
- (b) the general elections of the members of the Chilaw Urban Council and the Puttalam Urban Council which are due to be held for the purpose of electing new members in place of the members whose term of office has been extended to, and is due to expire on, January 31, 1951, shall be held in the month of January, 1951; and the provisions of that Ordinance shall in their application in the case of each such election have effect accordingly.
